Pending the successful completion of a Police Department background check and review of the Certificate of Liability Insurance by the City Attorney the license would be effective August 1, 2018 – December 31, 2018.

LICENSE FOR CLAYTON ENTERPRISES, LLC**

WHEREAS, Clayton Enterprises, LLC dba J&J Bowling/Bashers, has submitted an application for an On-sale Intoxicating Liquor License and a Sunday Liquor License to be located at 1802 4th Street NW, in the City of Faribault, consistent with Faribault City Code Chapter 4 and Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 340A; and

WHEREAS, Clayton Enterprises, LLC dba J&J Bowling/Bashers, has paid the required license fees and completed an application packet to request the license; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has completed a thorough background investigation of the associates of Clayton Enterprises, LLC dba J&J Bowling/Bashers, and the Chief of Police has certified that the applicants have not been convicted of any violation of any state law or municipal ordinance relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor within the past five years; and

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division will be consulted to determine that Clayton Enterprises, LLC dba J&J Bowling/Bashers, can operate as intended by holding an On-Sale Intoxicating Liquor License and a Sunday Liquor License.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF FARIBAULT RESOLVES, Clayton Enterprises, LLC dba J&J Bowling/Bashers, shall be issued an On-Sale Intoxicating Liquor License and Sunday Liquor License, for the term of August 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018.
