RESOLUTION #2018-168

REQUESTING PERMISSION FROM MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (MNDOT) TO MARK CROSSWALKS ON TH 60 (4TH ST NW) FROM LINCOLN AVENUE TO CENTRAL AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City of Faribault in conjunction with the Minnesota Department of Transportation is planning to improve Trunk Highway 60 (4th St NW) from Hulett Avenue to Central Avenue in 2019; and

WHEREAS, currently all intersections within the project limits with the exception of Hulett Avenue and Irving Avenue have existing marked crosswalks; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements include the construction of concrete sidewalks on both sides of TH 60 from Irving Ave to Central Ave as well as a concrete walkway on the north side of TH 60 from Irving Avenue to Hulett Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Faribault wishes to accommodate safe pedestrian crossings of TH 60 by maintaining marked crosswalks at all intersection crossings within the project limits with the exception of Hulett Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Faribault is formally requesting that MNDOT approve the maintaining of marked crosswalks at the intersections of TH 60 and Lincoln Avenue, 7th Avenue NW, 6th Avenue NW, 5th Avenue NW, 3rd Avenue NW and 1st Avenue NW, and a new crosswalk at Irving Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Faribault acknowledges if the requested designations are approved the City is responsible for the costs of installation of the crosswalk markings and ongoing maintenance of the crosswalk markings.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Faribault formally requests the approval to maintain the marked crosswalks at the intersections of TH 60 and Lincoln Avenue, 7th Avenue NW, 6th Avenue NW, 5th Avenue NW, 3rd Avenue NW and 1st Avenue NW, and a

new crosswalk at Irving Avenue and acknowledges it is responsible for installation costs and ongoing maintenance of the crosswalk markings.
