RE: Heritage Days 2019 Funding Request

Heritage Days was a success this year and was well attended. This year we are seeking \$4,500 from the City of Faribault which is the same as we received in 2018. This support will list the City of Faribault as a Pillar Donor and you will receive advertising during the event as well as in the Parade. We thank the City for all their efforts and appreciate all that they do to make this a great event for Faribault.

The 2018 Financial numbers are not in yet completely finalized but we do know that Heritage Days has been able to stop the losses and with both city and community support, we were able to pull in more money than we spent. While we were successful in reducing costs, the event is still fairly expensive. The continued support from the city will allow the board to add new events to the festival that attracts people from both in Faribault, as well as the surrounding communities.

The final request from the City of Faribault is to continue to sponsor the Youth activities that have been run in conjunction with Heritage Days. The City has sponsored this event with \$1500 in 2018. We are again requesting this funding in order to offer an evening of youth events. This evening has been jointly run in the past with volunteers from different organizations. This past year no organizations stepped forward to assist, so we had to run it ourselves. Typically there have been inflatables, karaoke, and a youth activities. We hope to find a group in the future to add more to this evening.

Attached we have included a copy of the financials to date. We still have several expenses that we are aware of. There is also a poster of all events offered in 2018 as a sample of what is offered for the event.
