Background:

Bethlehem Academy High School will be hosting its homecoming activities the week of September 24, 2018. The Homecoming Parade will be held on Friday, September 28, 2018, and they plan to use the same route as they have used in previous years. The parade will leave from the Bethlehem Academy parking lot on Third Avenue SW, continue north to Third Street NW, east to Central Avenue, south to First Street NW, west to Second Ave NW, south to First St SW and end at the Bethlehem Academy parking lot.

**APPROVE STREET CLOSURES FOR
BETHLEHEM ACADEMY HOMECOMING PARADE**

WHEREAS, Bethlehem Academy High School is hosting its annual Homecoming activities on Friday, September 28, 2018; and

WHEREAS, they plan to have their Homecoming Parade at 1:30 PM on September 28, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Faribault City Council is supportive of these events; and

WHEREAS, Section 15-57 of the Faribault Code of Ordinances provides for temporary parking restrictions by means of Council resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Third Avenue SW from Bethlehem Academy parking lot north to Third Street NW; then east to Central Avenue; then south to First Street NW; then west to Second Avenue NW; then south to First Street SW; then back to the Bethlehem Academy parking lot will be closed for the parade.

ALSO, BE IT RESOLVED, that the event sponsor should enter into the City's standard agreement regarding street closures and sponsored events.
