SUBJECT: Accept Proposal for Potential Contaminant Source Inventory Update

Background:

The completion of a Potential Contaminant Source Inventory (PCSI) is part of the City's Wellhead Protection Plan (WHPP). The PCSI examines potential contaminants that could potentially enter the City's drinking water source (ground water in the aquifer). A PCSI was not completed at the time the WHPP was originally developed in 2010, and needs to be completed as part of an upcoming required update.

Due to the complex and technical aspects of updating the index, staff has solicited a proposal to assist with the update. Attached is a copy of a proposal from Barr Engineering to conduct a PCSI update. Barr prepared the current WHPP that was submitted to the MDH in 2010. The cost of the proposal is \$8,420.00 and will be funded by a Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) Source Water Protection Grant that was approved by the passing of Resolution 2018-153.
