SUBJECT: Board and Commission Term Limits

Background:

The City Council has established numerous boards and commissions, as provided under Section 2.02 of the City Charter, and appoints some or all of the individuals to serve on those boards and commissions. The City Council representative appointments, where applicable, are typically made at the annual Council organizational meeting (held the first Tuesday in January) and are most commonly one year commitments, even if the other seats are for longer terms. Many of these boards and commissions tie back to state statutes, the City Code of Ordinances, or individual resolutions/ordinances approved by the City Council. Following is a list of the boards and commissions currently in place:

Most (not all) of the boards/commissions have assigned term lengths for the seats, but most of those do not specify any term limits (maximum number of terms and/or years). Exceptions to note include the EDA, which only allows two consecutive 6-year terms, and the HRA, which only allows a total of 15 years. There have been some questions raised as to how these positions are appointed year in and year out, with a concern that in some cases new people are not being sought to serve, and the existing members simply reappointed. On the other side of that discussion is the situation whereby the City often has difficulty in finding interesting applicants to apply. It is also helpful to maintain some level of experience and continuity on these boards/commissions.

With regards to seeking out new representatives to serve on these boards/commissions, it is recommended that each fall we publicize/advertise that there are openings for all of the positions for which the current appointees term is expiring. Applications will then be taken for them, to then be considered for appointment. This policy in no way is intended to discourage the existing appointee to request that they be considered for reappointment (if eligible).

A couple of questions that the Council is also being asked to provide direction on is whether any of the other boards/commissions should have any term limits and in what fashion (number of terms, total years, etc.). If there is an interest in establishing any term limits, then the next consideration would be is they be incorporated as hard policy, or rather be viewed more as guidelines.

Discussion:

Provide direction on advertising for board/commission appointments and incorporation of any additional term limits.

CITY CHARTER

Section 2.02. - Boards and commissions.

There shall be no separate, independent administrative boards or commissions, except those required by law or established by the council. The council may establish boards, commissions, committees, task forces or other groups to advise the council regarding municipal activities, to investigate subjects of interest to the city, or to perform quasi-judicial functions.
