SUBJECT: Approve Supplemental Agreement No. 2 with Foth for On-Call Aviation Services

Background:

Foth Infrastructure and Environment, LLC currently serves as the City's Airport Engineering consultant. Throughout the year, the need arises for services on various aviation matters that are not part of current Airport projects.

Because of the need to address matters resulting from storm damage in September 2018, the services in the current on-call services agreement (Task Order No. 8) were amended on October 23, 2018, with the approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 1.

These services have been exhausted and staff has asked Foth to prepare an additional Supplemental Agreement (No. 2) to address additional storm related matters. Under Supplemental Agreement No. 2, another \$20,000.00 is being requested to develop a bid package and provide construction administration services for the repair of City owned hangars damaged by the storm, as well as to provide a detailed cost estimate of the destroyed A/D Building & FBO hangar for insurance purposes. The new compensation amount under Task Order 8 is not to exceed \$45,000.00.

The proposed agreement is for on-call services for the Federal Fiscal Year's (FFY's) 2018-2019. The services associated with Supplemental Agreement No. 2 would be rendered from January 22 through May 27, 2019. The proposed agreement allows for the efficient and timely resolution of aviation related matters at the Airport. Funding will be provided by the City's insurance policy.

TASK ORDER No. 8

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 2

On-Call Services Federal Fiscal Year (FFYs) 2018-2019

In accordance with the Agreement between CITY and Consultant for Aviation Planning, Engineering and Surveying Services dated May 27, 2014 ("Agreement"), CITY and Consultant agree as follows:

Specific Project Data

The task order consists of providing on-call planning, engineering or surveying professional services to assist CITY staff with incidental requirements associated with the Faribault Municipal Airport through May 27, 2019.

1. Amended Services of Consultant

A. As a result of the tornado that damaged the Airport on September 20, 2018, the City requires a greater amount of consulting services for the recovery effort. Supplemental Agreement No. 1 raised the ceiling for fees from \$10,000 to \$25,000. With this increase a hangar demolition bid package has been prepared as well as a fence replacement package.

B. With this Supplemental Agreement No. 2 another \$20,000 is required to develop a bid package and provide construction administration services for the repair of hangars damaged by the storm as well as to provide a detailed cost estimate of existing FBO hangar for insurance purposes. Ceiling for Task Order 8 will be \$45,000 with this Supplemental Agreement.

2. City's Responsibilities

City's responsibilities in accordance with the Master Professional Services Agreement between Owner and Consultant for Professional Services dated May 27, 2014.

3. Times for Rendering Services

With this Supplemental Agreement the original schedule is not changed.

4. Payments to Engineer

Method of Payment shall be in accordance with the original Task Order as Standard Hourly Rate. The total compensation for services identified under Section 1 of this Supplement is **\$20,000**.

This Supplemental Agreement is subject to all the terms and conditions of the original Task Order Agreement dated April 10, 2018. Upon execution of this Supplemental Agreement, this document shall become part of the original Task Order 8.

Approval and Acceptance: Consultant is authorized to begin performance upon its receipt of a copy of this Supplemental Agreement signed by the City of Faribault.
