SUBJECT: Resolution 2019-076 Approve Street Closures for Mental Health Awareness Walk

Background:

Mark Wisdorf, representing Rice County Local Advisory Council, has contacted Staff regarding hosting the Mental Health Awareness Walk on Wednesday, May 22, 2019, from approximately 12:00 PM to 1:30 PM. This will require some street closures but barricades will not be used. The Faribault police and volunteers will assist with the intersections along the route.

The walk will begin at Buckham West (formerly the Senior Center) at 19 West Division Street, proceed east to Central Avenue, north on Central Avenue, west on 3rd Street, south on 2nd Avenue crossing Division Street on the bridge, east on 1st Street SW, and north of 1st Avenue SW returning to Buckham West. A completed indemnity agreement including insurance information will be provided prior to the event.

Recommendation:

Approve Resolution 2019-076 to intermittently close the listed roads for the Mental Health Awareness Walk on May 22, 2019.
