SUBJECT: Resolution 2019-077 Approve Plans and Specifications and Establish Bid Date for 2019A Street Reconstruction Project- City Contract 2019-04

Background:

The attached resolution approves the construction plans and specifications for the proposed 2019A Street Reconstruction Improvements project (Contract 2019-04). The proposed work includes removals, watermain replacement, sanitary sewer replacement, lot services, storm sewer construction, grading, aggregate base, bituminous paving, turf restoration, and related improvements.

The streets proposed to be included in this project are as follows:

Brand Avenue (Division Street E. to 5th Street SE)

14th Street NW from 2nd Avenue to 3rd Avenue was included in the feasibility report for this project but due to discussions with the owners of the Faribault Woolen Mills, it is anticipated that the Woolen Mills will be petitioning the City to vacate this portion of 14th Street NW in the next year or two, so the street improvements have been removed from this project. This project also includes the replacement of a portion of the sanitary sewer interceptor no. 2, that runs parallel to the south side of the railroad tracks between 7th Avenue NW and 4th Avenue NW.

The improvements were formally ordered by the City Council on February 12, 2019 upon the passage of Resolution 2019-031, following the Public Hearing. After the improvements were ordered, the Engineering Department finalized the plans and specifications in preparation of bidding the improvements.

The total estimated cost of the improvements is \$1,689,640.00 (including contingency and engineering fees). Proposed funding for the project comes from a number of sources, as outlined below:

The attached resolution also establishes a bid date of May 22, 2019 for the project. Construction is scheduled to begin in June, with substantial completion by the end of October 2019.

Brand Avenue (Division Street E. to 5th Street SE)

And the replacement of sanitary sewer trunk interceptor main from:

450' East of 7th Avenue NW to 950' East of 7th Avenue NW

And;

WHEREAS, said resolution also ordered the preparation of the plans and specifications for said improvements, and;

WHEREAS, the total cost of the improvements is estimated to be \$1,689,640.00, and;

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the improvements have been prepared by the City Engineering Department.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that plans and specifications for the 2019A Street Reconstruction Improvements project (Contract 2019-

04), prepared by the City Engineering Department, are hereby approved.

ALSO, BE IT RESOLVED, a bid opening date of May 22, 2019 is hereby established for the 2019A Street Reconstruction Improvements project (Contract 2019-04).

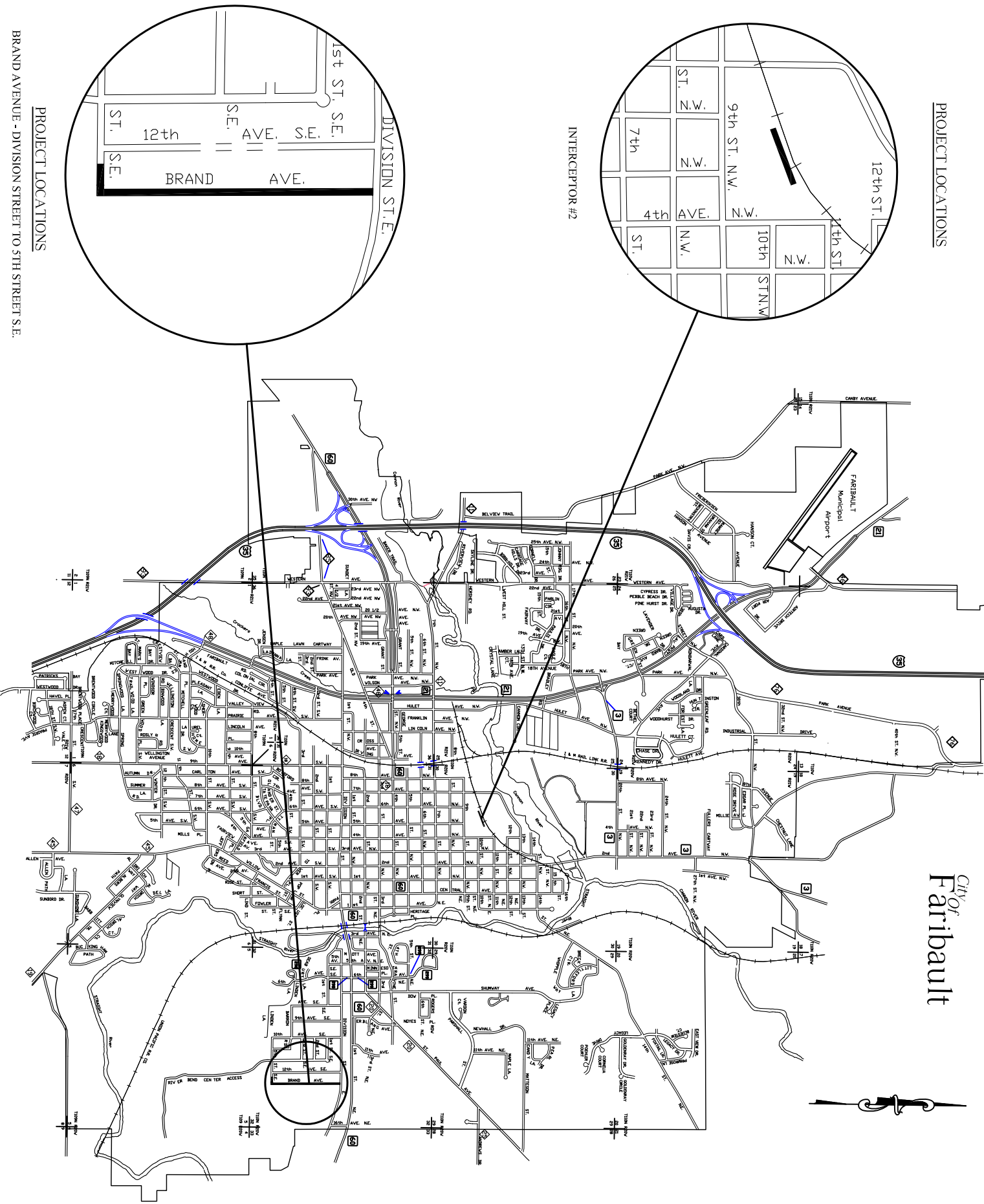

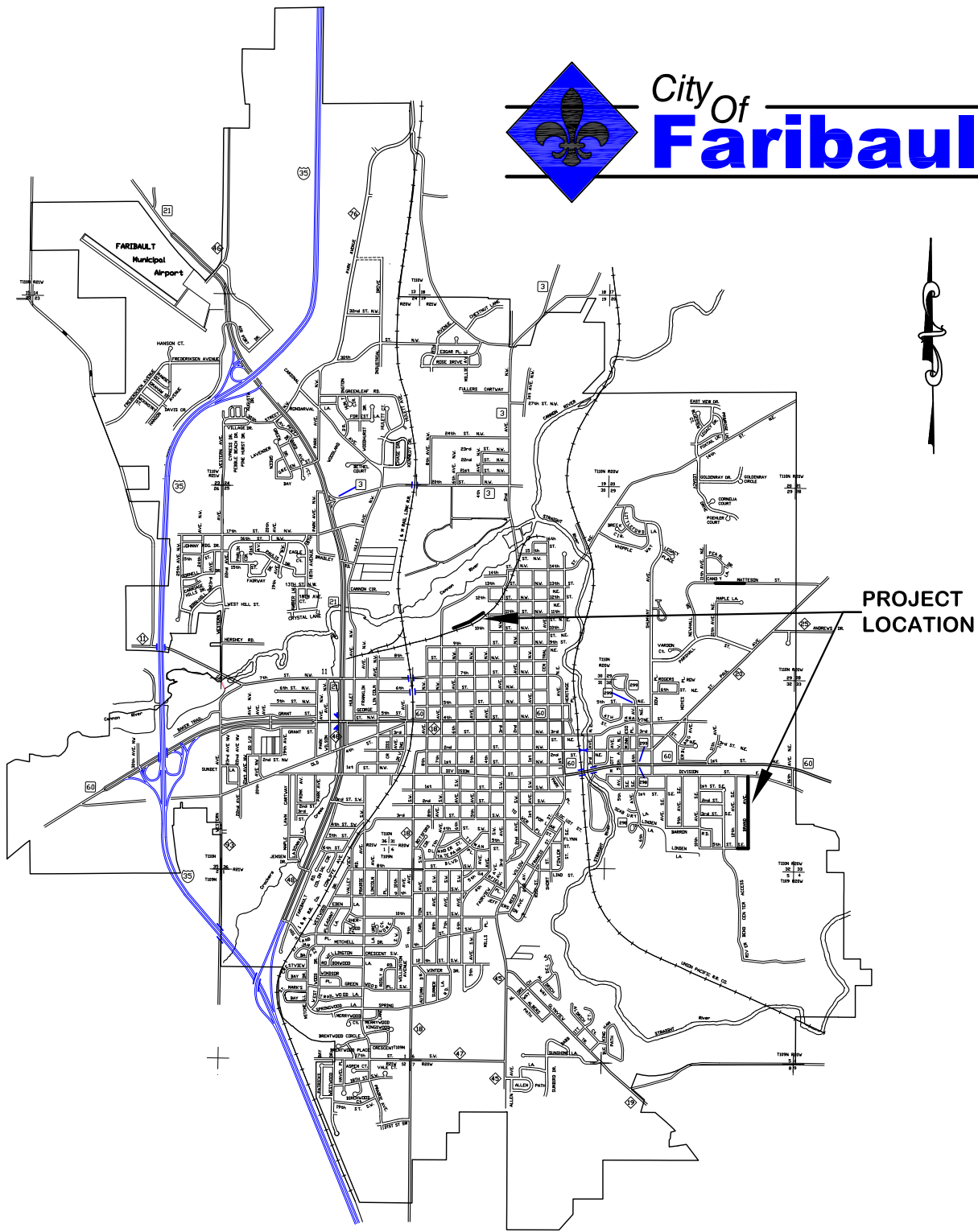
