A. 27 3rd Street NW and 225 1st Ave NW - Demolition

Staff presented the City's request that the HPC reconsider the issuance of a Certificate of Appropriateness for the demolition of two buildings in the local downtown historic district. Based on the preliminary findings of the Conditions Assessment report, and the estimated cost of \$3 million to bring the building back to a useable shell with no interior build-out or finished, the City wants to move forward with the demolition process.

Commissioners asked when the full report is expected. Staff noted it will be complete by the end of August/beginning of September. While they agreed the condition of the building likely warrants demolition, they want the opportunity to review the completed report.

A motion was made by Vohs and seconded by Dwyer to table the review until the completed Conditions Assessment is available for review. The motion passed unanimously.
