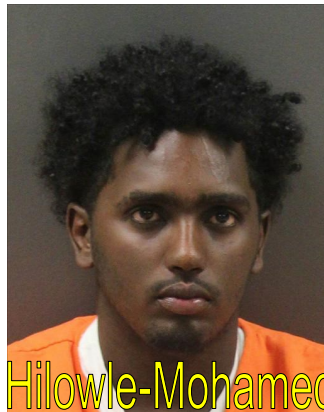

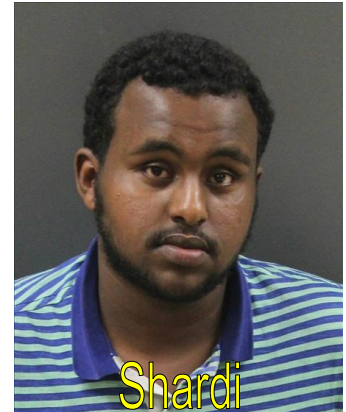

Suspects Arrested After Robbery

On Thursday, June 8th, **Officers Adam Marvin, Kara Christensen, John Gramling, Ben Johns, Karl Willers and Sergeant Matt Long** responded to a fight in progress. On arrival, Ofc. Marvin saw the victim, bleeding from his nose and mouth, in a parking lot. He told officers that he had been approached by two males who seemed intoxicated and were yelling at him. The males then began to punch and kick the victim. The victim stated two other males arrived in a vehicle, also assaulted him, and then all four suspects left in the vehicle. Witnesses at the scene gave officers a similar account and descriptions of the suspects. Officers later located the vehicle and two suspects at a residence. The victim was

brought to the scene and identified the two as the original assailants. The suspects, Fahad Hilowle-Mohamed, 23, and Abdul Shardi, 20, were arrested and jailed. Hilowle-Mohamed was charged with 1st degree Aggravated Robbery, and his bail was set at \$25,000 with condi-

tions. Shardi was also charged with 1st degree Aggravated Robbery and his bail was set at \$12,000 with conditions. Detectives are continuing to investigate to identify and locate the remaining two suspects.

Shoes Bring Smiles

On Friday, June 9th, we handed out 13 pairs of Nike sneakers and t-shirts to kids participating in the Connecting with Kids (CWK) program. **Chief Andy Bohlen, Captain Neal Pederson, Sergeant Matt Long and Officer Said Hilowle** were on hand to distribute shoes and visit with kids. The shoes were provided by a Faribault Pride grant as well as the CWK grant. Over the past 12 months, the grant has given officers and youth the opportunity to connect in recreational settings and build relationships.



Suspect Surrenders

On Wednesday, June 7th, **Officer Mallory House** met with a woman at the police department. She stated her ex-boyfriend had been keeping her at his apartment for several days and refused to let her leave. She also reported he had threatened and assaulted her numerous times. The suspect had taken the victim to Lakeville to avoid police contact. The victim was able to escape when the suspect used the bathroom. Assisted in searching by **Officers Adam Marvin**

and **Karl Willers**, the officers did not locate the suspect at the apartment. **Detectives DJ Skluzacek** and **Jeff Burbank** assisted in processing the apartment for evidence. Later the same date, the suspect, **Carlos Martinez, 28**, turned himself in to police in LeSueur County. Martinez was charged with Kidnapping, Domestic Assault by Strangulation, False Imprisonment, Domestic Assault (two counts) and Theft. His bail was set at \$75,000 with conditions.

Search Warrant Results in Two Arrests

On Wednesday, June 7th, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** executed a search warrant at a Faribault residence. The search warrant was the culmination of a cocaine trafficking investigation. Agents had previously purchased nearly 24 grams of cocaine from the suspect, **Donnie Jones, 37**. The suspect’s wife, **Jessica Higgs-Jones, 31**, was present during two of the drug sales. During the search, agents discovered evidence and paraphernalia indicating narcotics were being sold from the residence. These items tested positive for cocaine and marijuana, and were accessible to their three children. The couple were arrested and the children placed in

protective custody. Jones was charged with 1st degree Drugs - Sales, 3rd degree Drugs - Possession and Child Endangerment. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions. Higgs-Jones was charged with 5th degree Drugs - Possession and

Child Endangerment. She was released on her own recognizance by the court. The agents were assisted by **Detectives Matt Kolling, Scott Duncan, Sergeant Brandon Gliem** and **Officer Tony Larson**.
