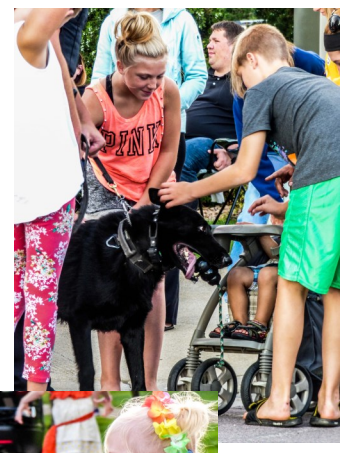

### Officers Nab Four

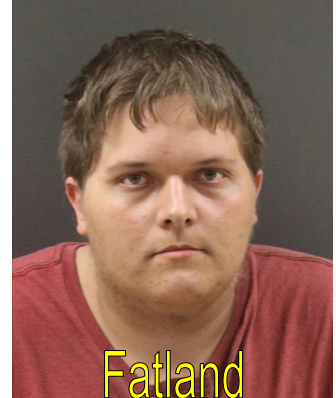
On Wednesday, August 9th, **Officers Sarah Tollefson, Matt Shuda, Said Hilowle, Sergeant Eric Sammon, RCSO Sergeant Jeff Mullenmeister and Deputy Steve Bauer & K9 Tank** responded to a report of vehicle tampering. On arrival, they observed four persons going through vehicles in a fenced area. Two of the males, Christian Morales, 18, and Elijah Fatland, 19, were apprehended leaving the area. Two juvenile males surrendered when officers and K9 Tank entered the yard. The suspects admitted to stealing from the cars, and items from the vehicles were found next to a hole in the fence. Morales and Fatland were jailed without

incident. The two juvenile males were transported to the Dakota County Juvenile Detention Facility. Both Morales and Fatland were each charged with Tampering with a Motor Vehicle, Possession of Burglary

Tools, Theft, and 4th Degree Criminal Damage to Property. They were both released on their own recognizance by the court. The two juveniles were also charged and released to the custody of their parents.

### Traffic Stop Nets Three

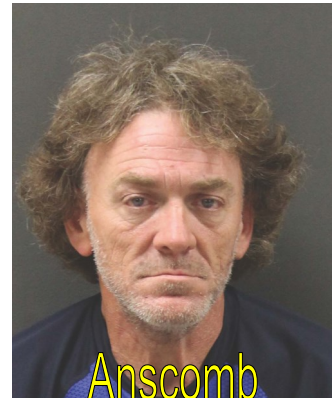
On Thursday, August 3rd, **Officer Karl Willers** stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. The driver, Ryan Plonski, 29, was unable to provide proof of insurance. **Officer Adam Marvin** arrived to assist. He noted one of the passengers, Johnathan Dallman, 32, was not wearing a seatbelt and, after checking his name, discovered he was the subject of an arrest warrant. He was taken into custody. **Officers Ben Johns and Josh Sjodin** also arrived to assist. Ofc. Marvin saw a glass methamphetamine pipe where another passenger, William Anscomb, 49, had been seated. Ofc. Sjodin discovered additional paraphernalia and a baggie of hallucinogenic mushrooms in Anscomb’s backpack. He was also arrested. While

patting down Plonski, Ofc. Willers discovered a small baggie that appeared to contain methamphetamine in his pocket, and he was arrested. Plonski was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances and No Proof of Insurance, and his bail was set at \$10,000 with

conditions. Anscomb was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances (two counts) and Possession of a Hypodermic Needle. His bail was set at \$15,000 with conditions. Dallman was transferred to LeSueur County on his warrant.
