## Kidnapping Arrest

On Sunday, December 31st, **Officers Michael Shuda, Tony Larson, Ben Johns, Josh Sjodin, Sergeant Matt Long** and **RCSO Deputy Colbey Hullett** responded to a 911 hangup. The caller stated there had been a protection order violation before disconnecting. The officers responded to the residence but did not find the caller. A few minutes later, another call was received reporting the victim and suspect were at a convenience store. The officers responded but again the caller was gone. A third call was received from the victim, and she stated she was at a grocery store and had

locked herself in the bathroom. Officers responded and found the suspect, Antonio Washington, 33, in a vehicle in the park-



ing lot and detained him. The victim was found inside the store. She told officers that Washington had shown up at her residence, took money from her, and threatened her not to testify in court. In fear for her safety, the victim went with Washington when he demanded a ride. The victim was able to convince him to stop at the grocery store from where she called for help. Washington was arrested and charged with Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO) Violation, Kidnapping, and Witness Tampering. His bail was set at \$350,000 with conditions.

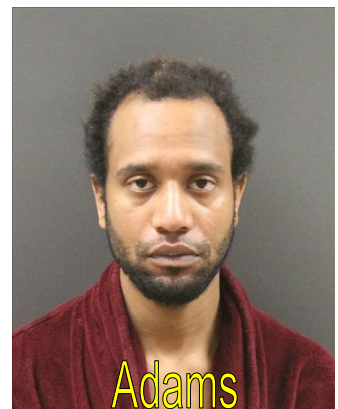

## Assault Arrest

On Thursday, January 4th, **Officers Josh Alexander, Sean Smallen, Sarah Tollefson, Mallory House, Allen Anderson** and **Chris Tonjum** responded to a reported disturbance. The caller reported that her son had hammers and was threatening her boyfriend. On their arrival, the victim told officers that the suspect, Jerome Adams, 22, had become upset and was threatening to harm him. He further stated Adams was "rampaging"

through the house while threatening his safety. Adams became disorderly and uncooperative with officers, but was taken into custody after a brief struggle. Adams was charged with 2nd degree Assault, Terroristic Threats, Domestic Assault and Obstructing Legal Process. He was released on his own recognition by the court.

Our recent Toward Zero Deaths enforcement wave netted one DWI arrest, one Driving After Revocation Arrests, two seatbelt citations and eight speeding citations. Additionally, two persons were arrested on outstanding warrants. State-wide enforcement efforts have contributed to the lowest number of fatalities since 1943.



## Bad Start to the New Year

On Monday, January 1st, **Officer Josh Sjodin** observed a vehicle on Central Avenue driving erratically. He stopped the vehicle and met with the driver, who displayed signs of intoxication. Ofc. Sjodin attempted to administer field sobriety tests, which the man either failed or refused to perform. The driver, Rolando Baltazar, 36, submitted to a preliminary breath test which showed his blood alcohol content was over .08, and he was

arrested. At the jail, Baltazar failed to provide an adequate breath sample for testing. Baltazar was cited for 2nd degree DWI, Refusal to Test, and Driving After Revocation. He was released on his own recognizance by the court.
