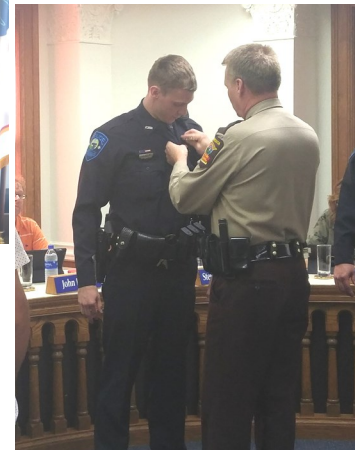
New Officer Sworn In

Officer Jacob Holm was sworn in before the City Council on Tuesday, September 11th. Following an introduction by **Chief Andy Bohlen**, the oath of office was given to Ofc. Holm by **City Administrator Tim Murray**. Coming from a law enforcement family, his badge was pinned on by his father, Minnesota State Patrol **Captain Mark Holm**. His mother, **Connie Holm**, watched on with pride, as she is also the department's administrative assistant. Ofc. Holm will undergo our 16-week Field Training program before starting out on his own.

Ofc. Holm is a graduate of Medford High School and Minnesota

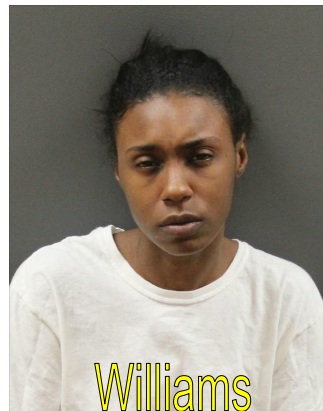


State University - Mankato. He has been working for us as both a Reserve Officer and CSO for the past 23 months.



Murder Investigation

On Friday, September 7th, officers were dispatched to an unknown 911 call. When she arrived, **Officer Brittany Carstensen** found that a male had been stabbed, a knife was on the floor next to the victim, and a female present denied stabbing him. **Detective John Gramling** quickly arrived to assist. The female was detained, and **Faribault Fire and North Ambulance** began to treat the victim. The victim was transported to Allina - District One Hospital where he was pronounced dead. **Officers Tony Larson, Lisa Petricka, Detectives John Gramling, Josh Alexander, Matt Shu-**

Bohlen responded to assist with the investigation. Bureau of Criminal Apprehension **Special Agent Aaron Churness** and the **Crime Scene Team** were contacted and responded to assist with processing the crime scene. During post-*Miranda* questioning, the suspect, Judana Williams, 24, stated she had been arguing with the victim and stabbed the victim when he "ran up on" her. Williams was arrested and jailed. She was charged with 2nd degree Murder and 2nd degree Assault. Her bail was set at \$100,000 with conditions.

Domestic Assault Arrest

On Sunday, September 9th, Officers Chris Tonjum, John Pesta, Cadie Spicer and Sergeant Eric Sammon responded to a reported domestic assault. The victim reported that her boyfriend had been huffing an aerosol can and had become violent. She stated that after the suspect threatened to kill her, he struck her several times, strangled her and threw her down. She reported losing consciousness at one point. The officers approached

the residence and found the suspect, Brandon Kath, 29, sitting inside. He was taken into custody without incident and jailed. In a post-Miranda statement, Kath admitted to being "messed up" and assaulting the victim. Kath was charged with Domestic Assault, Domestic Assault by Strangulation, and Terroristic Threats. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.
