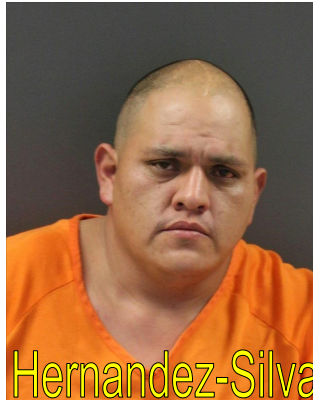

Task Force Arrest

As part of an ongoing narcotics investigation, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender task Force** executed a search warrant at a residence just outside of Faribault on Wednesday, October 24th. They were assisted by **Detectives Matt Shuda, Josh Alexander, RCSO Investigators Nate Hanson, Jason Witt, Dan Belcourt, Sergeants Paul LaRoche, Nate Budin and Deputy Steve Bauer.** Agents located evidence of metham-



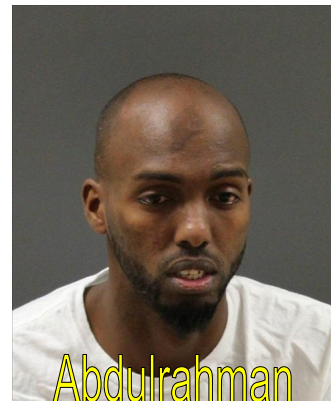

phetamine use, a sawed-off shotgun, and stolen savings bonds from Le Sueur County. Detectives obtained a second search warrant and recovered an ATV and several power tools believed to be stolen. The suspect, Apolinar Hernandez-Silva, 35, was arrested and jailed. He was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances, Receiving Stolen Property, and Possession of a Short-barreled Shotgun. His bail was set at \$25,000 with conditions.

Domestic Assault Arrest

On Tuesday, October 23rd, **Officers Karl Willers, Kara Christensen and Sergeant Brandon Gliem** responded to a reported disturbance. On their arrival, the caller told them she witnessed a male assault a female, and the female was yelling for help. The female was transported to District One Hospital for treatment. The victim told Ofc. Willers that the male, Abdirizak Abdulrahman, 22, became upset with her for talking to his family members. She further reported he slapped her face,

punched her in the chest and stomach and pinned her to the floor. She stated she was able to flee at one point, and ran down the sidewalk yelling for help when the caller saw her. Ofc. Willers could see signs of injury which coincided with the victim's report. Abdulrahman was located and denied to officers that he had assaulted the victim. He was arrested and jailed. He was charged with Domestic Assault, and released on his own recognizance by the court.

Oh, Brother

On Wednesday, October 24th, **Officer Brittany Carstensen** observed a male walking whom she knew to be the subject of an arrest warrant. She stopped the male, who provided a name and birthdate for his brother. Ofc. Carstensen checked a photo of the name provided and saw that it did not match the male. He then admitted his true name, Zachary Savoie, 27, and was arrested. While being processed at the jail, a Correctional Officer discovered Savoie to be concealing a small baggie near

his genitals. The baggie appeared to contain methamphetamine, which was confirmed by testing. In addition to his warrant, Savoie was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances, Giving a Peace Officer a False Name and DOB, and Introduction of Contraband into a Jail. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions (in conjunction with another case charging him with Financial Transaction Card Fraud).
