School Staff Training

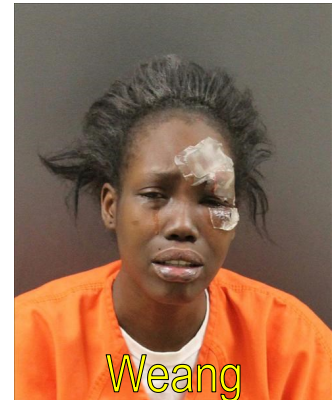

Domestic Assault Arrest

On Friday, January 19th, **Officers Chris Tonjum, Keith Voegel, Matt Shuda and Sergeant Mark Krenik** responded to a possible domestic disturbance. When they arrived they could heard voices inside the residence, and one person sounded in distress, yelling "get off me". The officers entered the residence and found the suspect dragging the victim into a bathroom. After they were separated, the victim told offic-

ers that she and the suspect had been arguing, and that the suspect, who was her sister, gets violent when intoxicated. The suspect, Bham Weang, 23, was arrested and jailed. She was charged with Domestic Assault and released on her own recognizance by the court.

Search Warrant Nets Three

On Monday, January 21st, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** executed a search warrant at a Faribault residence. The agents were assisted by **Detectives Brittany Carstensen, Ben Johns, John Gramling, Officers Tony Larson, Josh Sjodin, Sergeant Matt Long, RCSO Investigators Nate Hanson, Jason Witt and Dan Belcourt.** The search warrant was the result of a narcotics trafficking investigation. Inside the residence, agents found items containing residue of methamphetamine and marijuana wax, suboxone strips, and paraphernalia used for drug sales. Agents also found a large

pile of used syringes and tubes which had been used for heroin consumption. The agents arrested Chaylen Rader, 36, who was charged with 3rd degree Controlled Substances. His bail was set at \$20,000 with conditions. Alex Rader, 34, was charged with 3rd degree Controlled Substances, and his bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions. Valerie Roehl, 32, was arrested pursuant to four warrants. She was also charged with 3rd degree Controlled Substances and 5th degree Controlled Substances, and her bail was set at \$50,000 with conditions.

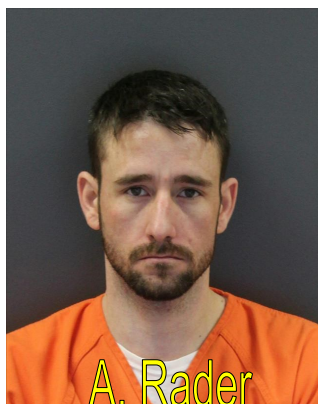

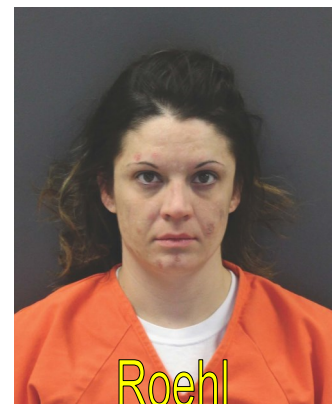
