Road Trip

On Monday, January 29th, **Officers Tony Larson and Josh Alexander** responded to a local bank for a reported fraud. Bank staff reported that a woman had been in the bank with a fraudulent ID card attempting to cash a check. The bank had been made aware of the suspect through information from other banks. Ofc. Larson saw the woman walking outside the bank and stopped to speak with her. The suspect, Kimberly Knight, 55, told Ofc. Larson that she was on a trip with her

nephew and was short on cash. She further stated she had received the check from an unknown male, and knew the check was fraudulent but attempted to cash it anyhow. She was in possession of a California ID and credit cards for a different person. Knight admitted to prior arrests for the same crimes, and was also discovered to be the subject of two arrest warrants from New Jersey. Knight was arrested without incident. She was charged with Check Forgery and Identity

Theft. Her bail was set at \$20,000 with conditions.

Domestic Assault Arrest

On Tuesday, January 29th, **Officers Karl Willers, Michael Shuda, Jacob Holm and Kara Christensen** responded to a reported domestic assault. On their arrival, officers found the victim standing outside in a bathrobe. She reported to officers that, during an argument with her husband, he grabbed her throat and tried to strangle her. She was able to get away from him and sent a message to a friend,



who then called police. The suspect told officers that no physical assault had taken place, and that the victim was lying to officers. The suspect, Kelvin Patrick, 31, was arrested and jailed. He was charged with Domestic Assault (two counts), and was released on his own recognizance by the court.

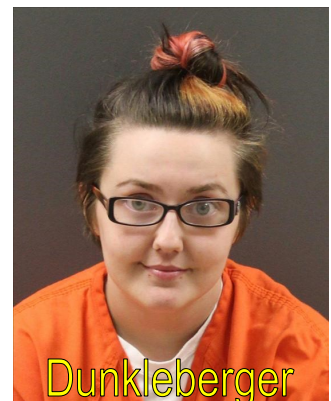
Warrant Watch

This week, we're looking for Dakota Greybuffalo, 27. He is wanted for probation violation related to a conviction for 5th degree Controlled Substances and Carrying a Pistol without a Permit. Greybuffalo is 5'8" tall, weighs 150 pounds, has black hair and brown eyes.
