Two Days, Two Arrests

On Tuesday, February 5th, **Officers Kara Christensen, Jacob Holm and Sergeant Brandon Gliem** responded to a 911 hang-up call. The officers recognized the address from previous domestic assault calls. On their arrival, they saw footprints leading from the residence and found the suspect, Shantice Caffey, 26, a short distance away. Officers also knew that Caffey was the subject of a Domestic Assault No Contact Order (DANCO) and was barred from the residence. She was arrested and jailed,

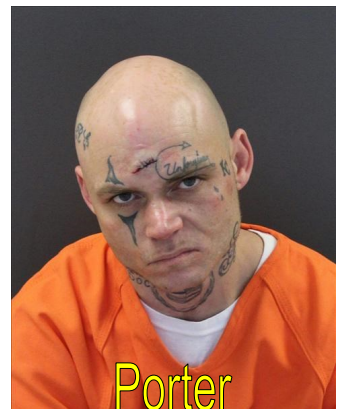


charged with Violation of a DANCO. She was released on her own recognizance by the court the following day. Less than six hours after her release, **Officers Adam Marvin and Holm** were called back to the residence by a child protection worker who believed Caffey was again inside the residence. After speaking with the resident, Caffey came out from hiding and was again arrested for Violation of a DANCO (two counts). Her bail was set at \$30,000 without conditions.

Not a Happy Customer

On Wednesday, February 7th, **Officers Josh Sjodin, Tony Larson and Sergeant Matt Knutson** responded to a disturbance call. As they spoke with the persons involved, the victim stated she was trying to retrieve her vehicle from the suspect, and there was a dispute over ownership. The victim was very upset and told officers that as she was sitting in the vehicle, the suspect smashed out the window, causing her to fear for her safety. The suspect told officers he did smash the windows with a ham-

mer. The suspect, Cecil Porter, 36, was arrested for domestic assault. He became upset and uncooperative with officers. Porter hit the side of a squad car with his head, causing a dent. Inside the car, he banged his head against the partition. As he was bleeding, he spit blood toward the officer and around the inside of the car. Porter was charged with Domestic Assault - felony, 4th degree Assault and 3rd degree Damage to Property. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.

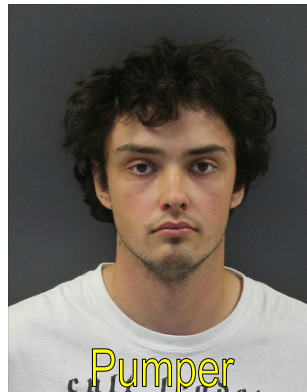

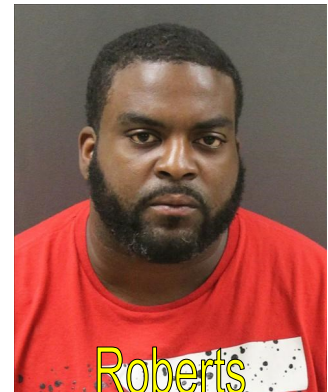
Warrant Watch
