Meritorious Service Awards

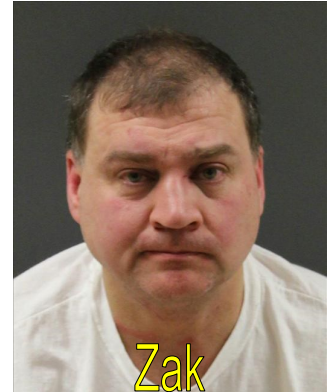

Domestic Assault Arrest

On Friday, February 8th, **Officers Sarah Tollefson, Bill Considine, Scott Duncan, Matt Shuda, Adam Marvin, Chris Tonjum and Sergeant Mark Krenik** responded to a domestic assault. The officers were told that the suspect had been arguing with his wife and son. The suspect attempted to drive from the residence but they tried to stop him as he was intoxicated. The suspect assaulted both his wife and son and then left the residence. The officers also observed tracks in the driveway which

indicated the suspect backed his vehicle out of the garage, struck his son's vehicle and pushed it across the street where it struck another parked vehicle. The suspect, Robert Zak, 49, was stopped by deputies. Ofc. Considine arrived, administered field sobriety tests, and arrested Zak. He was jailed and charged with Domestic Assault by Strangulation, Domestic Assault (two counts), and Fail to Stop for a Collision. He was released on his own recognizance by the court.

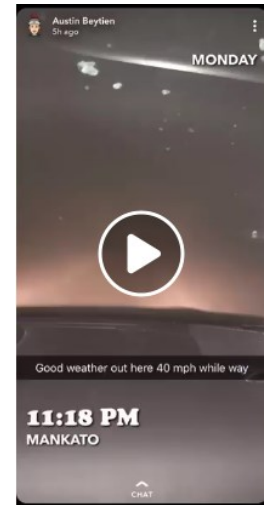

Domestic Assault Arrest

He was released on his own recognizance by the court.
