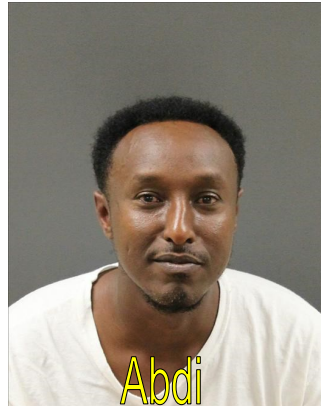

Domestic Assault Arrest

On Wednesday, August 14th, **Officers Jacob Holm, Bill Considine, Scott Duncan and Sergeant Mark Krenik** responded to a reported domestic assault. On their arrival, the victim told Ofc. Holm that she and her husband were traveling to Minneapolis to shop, but he kept her locked in their motel room. She further stated he would not let her leave the room, and he had physically assaulted her prior to the officers' arrival. The officers could



see marks and bruises on her arms and neck. She also reported that he had strangled her until she vomited. The suspect, **Abdinasir Abdi, 34**, denied assaulting the victim, but did state he held her in the room because she did not know the city. Abdi was arrested and charged with Domestic Assault and Domestic Assault by Strangulation. His bail was set at \$5,000 with conditions.

The end of summer DWI enforcement wave starts August 16 and continues through September 2. Our TZD officers will be out looking for impaired drivers to help motorists wind up summer on a safe note. As always, they'll also be on the lookout for other unsafe driving behaviors as well, particularly the new hands-free law. Be sure

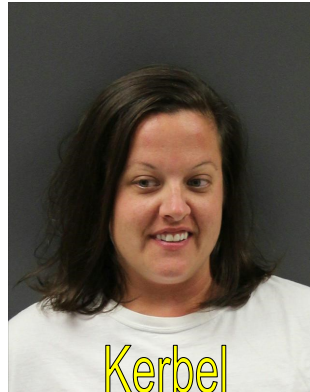

DWI Enforcement

On Saturday, August 10th, **Officers Josh Sjodin and Lisa Petricka** responded to a suspicious vehicle report. On their arrival, they found a female sleeping in her vehicle. When she awoke and opened the window, Ofc. Sjodin could smell a strong odor of marijuana. Ofc. Sjodin noticed the driver, Melissa Kerbel, 39, was unsteady on her feet when she

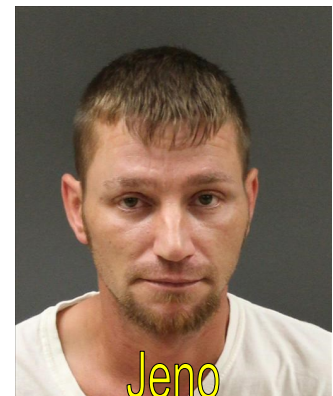


got out of the car. The officers found two marijuana ends and an Altoids tin in the vehicle. The tin contained numerous pills and a white residue, which later tested positive as methamphetamine. Kerbel was arrested and charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances. She was released on her own recognizance by the court.

DANCO Violation

On Wednesday, August 7th, **Officers Michael Shuda, Spencer Angle, Karl Willers, Sean Smallen and Sergeant Brandon Gliem** responded to a reported fight. A witness reported several males had been fighting at a neighboring residence. While all of the persons involved were gone when officers arrived, one of the males was identified as Joshua Jen0, 32, who was barred from the residence by a Domestic Abuse No

Contact Order (DANCO). The following evening, Officers Angle and Willers saw Jen0 driving a vehicle and stopped him. He denied being at the residence, but did state he was with his wife (which was also a violation of the DANCO). Jen0 was arrested and charged with Violation of a DANCO. His bail was set at \$1,000 with conditions.
