## Domestic Assault Arrest

On Friday, October 4th, **Officers Karl Willers, Spencer Angle, Sean Smallen and Tony Kuchinka** responded to a reported domestic assault. A citizen reported seeing a male strike a female in the face, and then heard the male yelling "you're dead!" On their arrival, they met with both the male and female. The officers could see swelling and redness around the victim's eye and forehead. They also saw broken and over-

turned furniture in the residence. The victim told officers the suspect became angry at her and punched her in the face, and continued to punch her and throw things inside the residence. The suspect, Dammon Nailon, 37, denied any physical assault of the victim. He was arrested and jailed. He was charged with Domestic Assault - felony (two counts), and his bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.

## Purple Patch Project

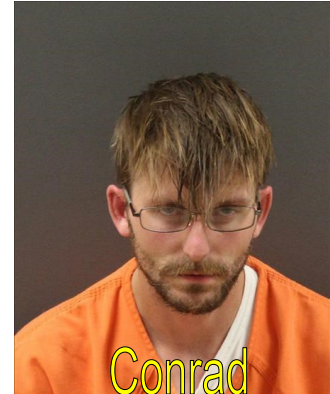
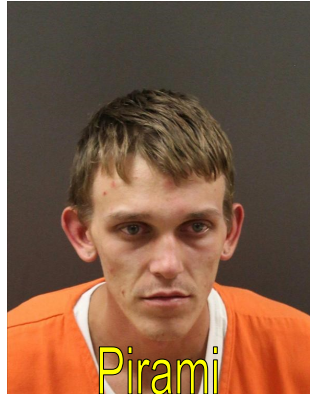

## Domestic Assault Arrest

On Thursday, October 3rd, **Officer Michael Shuda** responded to a call of a suspicious vehicle. On his arrival, he found two males sleeping in a parked car. Ofc. Shuda could see drug paraphernalia and packaging inside the vehicle. **Officers Spencer Angle, Sean Smallen and Adam Marvin** arrived to assist. After waking the pair, officers searched them and the vehicle. They recovered over 10 grams of methamphetamine, 116 grams of marijuana, Oxycodone pills and methamphetamine pipes. The suspects were identified as Dustin Pirami, 27, and Jeffery Conrad, 34. The



pair were each charged with 2nd degree Controlled Substance - Sales, 3rd degree Controlled Substances - Possession, and 5th degree Con-

trolled Substances (three counts). Pirami's bail was set at \$5,000 with conditions, and Conrad's bail was set at \$50,000 with conditions.

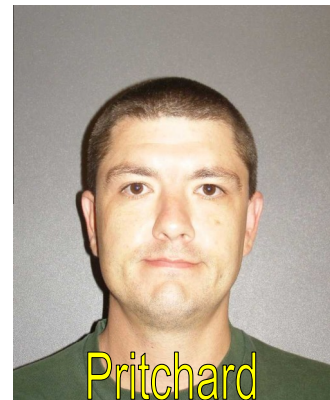

## Domestic Assault Arrest

On Monday, October 7th, **Officers Spencer Angle and Josh Alexander** responded to a reported domestic assault. The victim told officers her ex-boyfriend was mad at her for shopping, and became more upset when she wouldn't give him any money. She reported he struck her numerous times while driving, and she finally ran from his vehicle out of fear for her safety. Officers were not able to locate the suspect, Josh-

ua Pritchard, 43. The following day, **Detective Jeff Burbank** saw Pritchard and called for assistance. **Sergeants Eric Sammon and Brandon Gliem** arrived and arrested Pritchard. He was charged with Domestic Assault - felony (two counts), and his bail was set at \$15,000 with conditions.
