This year's kickoff event was hosted by the Northfield Police Department. At the event, **Officer Michael Shuda** was recognized for having made 21



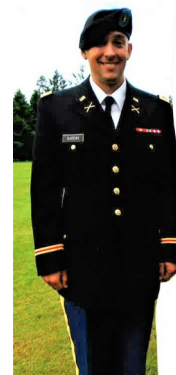
DWI arrests over the past TZD grant cycle. This is the highest number of DWI arrests of all Rice County officers over the grant cycle. The arrests were

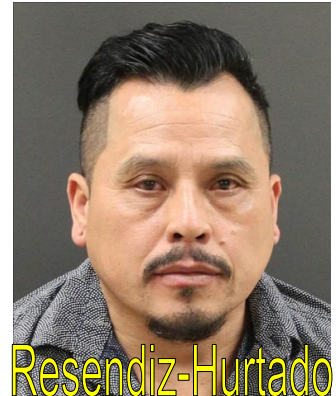

### DWI Arrest

On Saturday, November 23rd, **Officer Jacob Holm** stopped a vehicle travelling over the posted speed limit. The driver told Ofc. Holm that he had a California drivers license, but did not have it with him and was evasive about his identity. The driver displayed signs of intoxication. Ofc. Holm administered standardized field sobriety tests to the driver, and a preliminary breath test indicated a blood alcohol content

(BAC) of .10. He was arrested and transported to the jail. His identity was determined to be Julian Resendiz-Hurtado, 46. He submitted to a breath test, which confirmed his (BAC) of .10. Jail staff also determined that Resendiz-Hurtado was the subject of a warrant. He was charged with 3rd degree DWI and Driving Without a Valid License and his bail was set at \$1,000 with conditions.

### Overdose Arrest

On Monday, November 25th, **Officers Josh Alexander, Jacob Holm, Matt Shuda, Scott Duncan and Sergeant Matt Knutson** responded to a reported unconscious woman at a local parking lot. Officers found the victim breathing but unresponsive. Bystanders told officers that the victim was not using drugs, but thought she had a seizure. Medical personnel reported the victim responded to Narcan treatment, indicating she likely suffered an

opioid overdose. **Detective Jeff Burbank** responded to assist with the investigation. The victim admitted to using heroin. One of the bystanders, Victoria Carrejo, 19, admitted to Det. Burbank she had provided heroin to the victim and another friend. Carrejo was arrested and charged with Great Bodily Harm-Cause by Distribution and 2nd degree Controlled Substances. Her bail was set at \$40,000 with conditions.
