Domestic Assault Arrest

Burglary Arrest

On Sunday, February 9th, **Officers Kara Christensen, Lisa Petricka and Sergeant Brandon Gliem** responded to a disturbance call. They spoke with the resident, who told officers he was awakened by an intoxicated male pounding on the door. The male told the resident he was looking for his "wife". The resident went back into his home, and a few minutes later saw the male standing inside the residence holding a knife. He yelled at the male to leave and he did. Offic-



ers found the male, Justin Thanghe, 24, who told officers he had been having relationship problems with his girlfriend and believed she was in the residence. He also stated he was looking for his video game system she had. He denied having a knife, and stated he bumped a shelf and a knife fell to the ground. Thanghe was arrested and charged with Burglary (two counts) and Trespassing. He was released on his own recognition by the court.

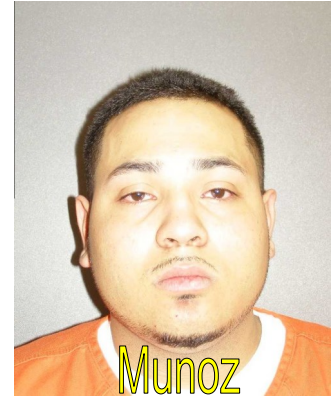

OFP Arrest

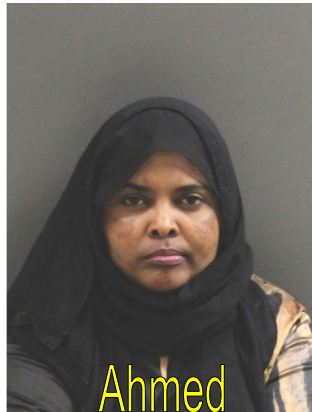
On Thursday, February 6th, **Officer Spencer Angle** responded to a reported court order violation. The caller told Ofc. Angle that she had an Order for Protection in place against her husband. She further reported that he had been trying to call her and had sent several her text messages. She showed the messages to Ofc. Angle, as well as played voicemail messages left by the suspect. Ofc. Angle located the

suspect, Apolinar Munoz, 30, and arrested him. He was charged with Violation of an Order for Protection, and his bail was set at \$1,000 with conditions.



Assault Arrest

On Monday, February 10th, **Officers Lance Ulrich, Sean Smallen, Adam Marvin and Sergeant Brandon Gliem** responded to a reported disturbance. The officers spoke with a woman and several witnesses who reported that they had seen the suspect, Zamzam Ahmed, 29, break a window in the woman’s car. When they had confronted Ahmed, she struck another woman in the eye. Ofc. Marvin and Sgt. Gliem arrested Ahmed, who verbally and physically resisted the officers. She was eventually hand-



cuffed and transported to jail. In a post-Miranda interview and with the assistance of an interpreter, she told **Officers Bill Considine and Sarah Tollefson** that she did not assault anyone and denied damaging the vehicle. Ahmed was charged with 4th degree Damage to Property, 5th degree Assault, Tampering with a Motor Vehicle, False Information to a Peace Officer and Obstructing Legal Process. She was released on her own recognizance by the court.

Warrant Watch
