New Eyes

This week, most of our in-squad cameras were upgraded and replaced with AXON Fleet 2 cameras. The remaining squads will be outfitted with the new cameras as they are replaced in the next couple of months. The system replaces an outdated DVR system. The new cameras integrate with our body-worn cameras, provide clearer footage and will be less work for staff to maintain. The footage also utilizes cloud-based storage, eliminating the need to replace and maintain our own server. The cameras were purchased through a generous donation by Tom McDonough.



Domestic Assault Arrest

On Sunday, February 16th, Officers **Lisa Petricka**, **Kara Christensen** and **Sergeant Matt Knutson** responded to a reported domestic assault. The victim reported she had told her boyfriend to leave the residence, and he pushed her down. When she called for help, he reportedly told her that if she was calling the police, he would really hurt her next time. The suspect, Robert Abrams, 26, was found outside



of the residence. He was upset and yelling, and denied assaulting the victim. He was arrested and charged with Domestic Assault - felony. His bail was set at \$10,000 with conditions.

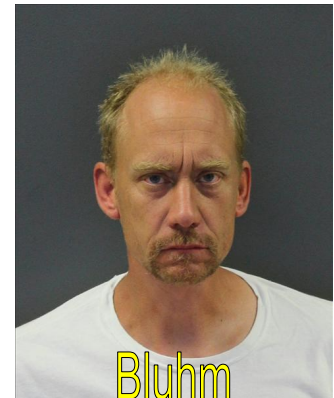

Pursuit Arrest

On Thursday, February 19th, **Detective Jeff Burbank** saw a vehicle which he believed to be used by Joshua Bluhm, 44. He knew Bluhm to be the subject of an arrest warrant. When Det. Burbank attempted to stop the vehicle, it sped off. **Officers Matt Kolling, Dustin Vanderbeek, Tony Larson and Captain Dave Dillon** responded to assist. The van continued to flee, weaving around other cars causing them to take action to

avoid a collision. The vehicle pulled into a driveway and the driver attempted to run. Det. Burbank caught the driver, confirmed to be Bluhm, and arrested him. Bluhm's driving privileges were found to be suspended. A passenger in the van, Debra Livingston, 54, was also arrested on two arrest warrants. Bluhm was charged with Fleeing a Peace Officer and Driving After Suspension. His bail was set at \$40,000 without conditions.



Assault Arrest

On Wednesday, February 19th, **Officers Sarah Tollefson and Bill Considine** responded to a reported domestic assault. Ofc. Tollefson met with the victim at Allina-District One Hospital, where she was being treated for her injuries. She reported that her fiancé had thrown a baby bottle at her, striking her in the face. Ofc. Considine found the suspect, Dustin Fredrickson, 32, at his residence. He admitted to the as-

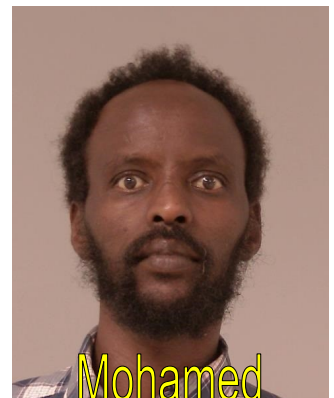
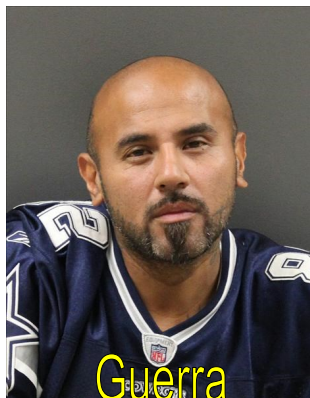


sault, and was placed under arrest. He was charged with Domestic Assault - felony (two counts), and he was released on his own recognizance by the court.

Warrant Watch

This week, we're looking for Eduardo Guerra, 41. He is the subject of a warrant for 2nd degree Assault and Domestic Assault. He is also wanted for failing to appear in relation to DWI charges, and a probation violation warrant from another DWI conviction. Guerra is 5'9" tall, weighs 195 pounds, has brown eyes and black hair.

We're also Abdi Mohamed, 37. He is the subject of two warrants for 5th degree Controlled Substances and Criminal Trespassing. Mohamed is 5'5" tall, weighs 105 pounds, has brown eyes and black hair.
