## Champion Recognized

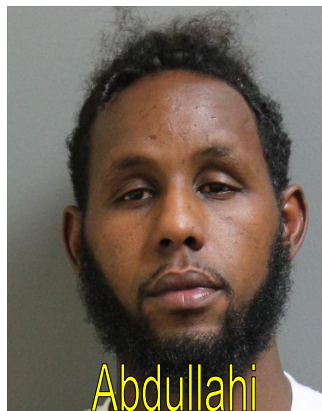
On Wednesday, February 26th, **Evidence Technician Gina Palan** was presented with the Asset Champion Award. The award is presented monthly by the Rice County Chemical and Mental Health Coalition. Katie Reed and Becky Ford of the Coalition presented the award for her work with the Take It To The Box program. On a daily basis, Gina empties, packages and stores disposed medications for incineration. She also helps coordinate incineration dates with Northfield PD and Rice County SO. To date, 14,341 pounds of medication has been disposed of in Faribault.

## Stolen Vehicle, Stolen Checks

On Wednesday, February 26th, **Officer Kara Christensen** and **Sergeant Brandon Gliem** responded to a local bank who reported a man attempting to cash a suspected stolen check. The bank staff reported the man first presented an unsigned check for \$500. When told they could not cash it, he left and returned a short time later and attempted to cash another check for \$1,000. The suspect, Faisal Abdullahi, 30, was arrested. He was found in possession of several similar



checks. **Detective Ben Johns** assisted with follow-up. The account holder was contacted, and stated the man had approached him earlier that day looking for work. A short time later, he noticed his checkbook missing. Additional investigation showed that keys found in Abdullahi's possession belonged to a vehicle stolen from Owatonna. Abdullahi was charged with Receiving Stolen Property and Check forgery. His bail was set at \$2,000 with conditions.

### OFP Arrest

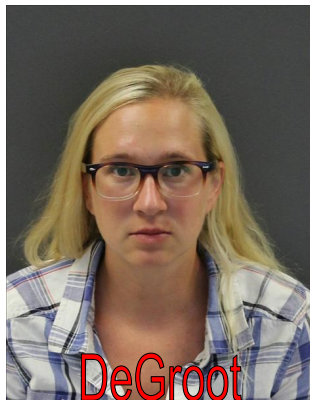
On Saturday, February 22nd, **Officers Dustin Vanderbeek** and **Tony Larson** responded to a reported protection order violation. The victim reported that she went to a meeting at her late brother’s residence and found her ex-husband there. She reported that he made several comments to her about purchasing the residence and then left the scene. After speaking with other witnesses, the officers found the suspect, Phillip Muchow, 60. He admitted going to the residence but



did not think the victim would be there. He did admit to speaking to the victim. He was arrested and jailed. A short time later, **Officers Brad Arens** and **Josh Alexander** were called to the jail. Correctional deputies reported finding suspected methamphetamine in Muchow’s belongings. He was charged with Violation of an Order for Protection and 3rd degree Controlled Substances. He was released on his own recognizance by the court.
