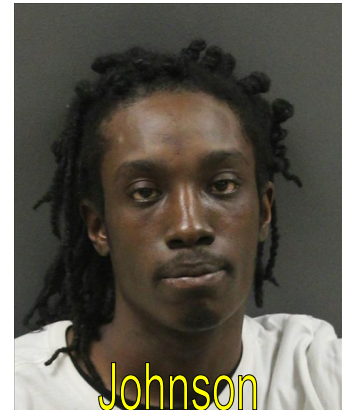

Domestic Assault Arrest

On Tuesday, March 2nd, **Officers Ben Borash, Jacob Holm and Tony Kuchinka** responded to a reported domestic assault. The victim reported her former boyfriend came to her residence, and forced his way inside when she opened the door. She stated he pushed her and strangled her until another male pulled him off of her. Officers could see marks on her neck. The suspect, **Contrell Johnson, 31**, was

located a short distance away. He stated the victim assaulted him, although he displayed no injuries. Johnson was arrested and jailed. He was charged with Domestic Assault - felony, Domestic Assault by Strangulation, and 1st degree Burglary. His bail was set at \$20,000 with conditions.

Warrant Arrest

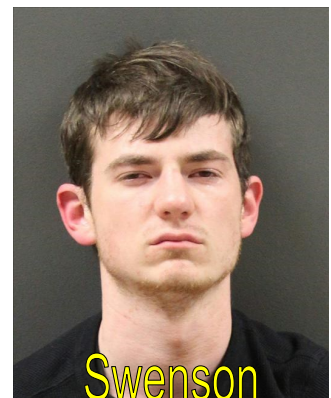
Warrant Watch

Preblich is 5'4" tall, weighs 120 pounds, has brown eyes and blond hair.

We're also looking for Kodie Swenson, 23. He's wanted for failing to appear on charges of 3rd degree DWI, Driving After



Revocation, and No Insurance. Swenson is 6'1" tall, weighs 160 pounds, has brown eyes and brown hair.
