

## DWI Arrest

On Tuesday, March 10th, **Officers Adam Marvin, Dustin Vanderbeek and Ben Borash** responded to a reported hit and run. The caller told officers that a small SUV had run over the mailboxes in front of his residence. Fortunately, the fresh snow that night helped officers track the vehicle down, and they found it parked nearby. The officers met with a woman at the residence who admitted to driving the vehicle.


The officers identified her as Fransisca Ogdahl, noted she showed signs of impairment, and field sobriety tests were administered. Ogdahl was arrested and transported to the jail, where she provided a breath sample which showed a blood alcohol content of .26. Ogdahl was charged with 2nd degree DWI and Hit and Run. She was released on her own recognizance with conditions.




### St. Pat’s Safety

### Warrant Arrest

On Friday, March 6th, **Officer Michael Shuda** stopped a vehicle for equipment violations. As he met with the occupants, he asked the female passenger her name, who gave her middle name as her last name. When checking her name, he discovered her true name was Alexis Farless, 23, and that she was the subject of two arrest warrants. She was arrested, and her belongings were searched. Ofc. Shuda found drug para-



phernalia, a baggie with suspected methamphetamine residue, a baggie with suspected heroin, several syringes and a glass pipe with residue. Farless was transported to the jail and charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances - felony, 5th degree Controlled Substances - gross misdemeanor, and Possession of Hypodermic Needles. Her bail was set at \$2,000 with conditions.

### Things Not to Do When You Have a Warrant

On Frida, March 6th, **Officer Tony Larson** was on patrol when he heard a man shouting at him. He stopped to check, and the man pointed to another man walking away, and stated he just threw a fast food bag in his yard. Ofc. Larson stopped the suspect, who stated he “accidentally dropped the bag”, but had not made any effort to pick it up. After a brief discussion about the need to provide his name to the officer, he was

identified as James Schmidt, 24, and discovered he was the subject of several arrest warrants. Schmidt was arrested and searched. In his possession were a small bag of marijuana, a scale with suspected methamphetamine residue, and several small baggies consistent with narcotics sales. Schmidt was jailed and charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances, and his bail was set at \$5,000 with conditions.
