SUBJECT: Review Proposals for Internet and Phone Service to City Facilities

The City's Information Technology (IT) Division has received quotes from several telecommunications firms for internet and telephone services. As the City's data needs continue to grow, and the options to serve the various City buildings expand, looking for a comprehensive service contract was done to both improve speed/capacity as well as reduce costs. We will review the proposals with the committee, and then take the recommendation forward to City Council for approval.

Proposals for the replacement of the phone system were also requested, as the City's current telephone system is nearly 20 years old and in need of updating. While currently included in the Capital Improvement Plan for 2022, a new system is recommended due to its condition, minimal features, and other limitations.
