SUBJECT: Ordinance 2020-9 Amend Sec. 15-40. On-street durational parking limits. of the City Code of Ordinances regarding On-Street Parking Time Limit – Second Reading

Background:

The issue of parking time limits on streets was raised during the Joint Committee meeting on November 19, 2019. Other than streets with specifically posted parking time limits, the default maximum period of time that a vehicle can be parked on a street is eighteen (18) hours in a 24-hour period during the week (not on weekends).

Following discussion at the July 7, 2020 Joint Council Committee meeting, there was support for a longer time frame, electing to go with the proposed limit of 72 hours (3 days). The proposed change would apply into/over weekends as well. First reading was approved on July 14, 2020, and there have been no comments received or revisions made.

**AMEND SEC. 15-40 – ON-STREET DURATIONAL PARKING LIMITS.
OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING ON-STREET
PARKING TIME LIMIT**

THE CITY OF FARIBAULT ORDAINS: The City Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 15-40(a) of Chapter 15 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Faribault is hereby amended by adding the double-underlined language and deleting the ~~stricken~~ language as follows:

Sec. 15-40. - On-street durational parking limits.

(a) *All vehicles.* No person in charge of any vehicle shall park or permit such vehicle to stand upon any street in the city for more than ~~eighteen (18) hours in a twenty-four hour period, Monday through Friday~~ seventy two (72) consecutive hours, unless otherwise provided.

Section 2. This ordinance amendment shall take effect and be in force after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 3.05 of the City Charter.
