SUBJECT: Resolution 2020-016 Initiate Project and Order Feasibility Report for 2021 Street Reconstruction Improvements – Contract 2021-03

Background:

Attached is a routine resolution initiating a project and ordering a feasibility report for the 2021 Street Reconstruction Improvements project (Contract 2021-03), including removals, watermain replacement, sanitary sewer replacement, lot services, storm sewer construction, grading, aggregate base, bituminous paving, turf restoration and related improvements.

The streets proposed to be included in this project are as follows:

20th Street NW	(2nd Avenue NW to East End)
Faribault Road	(Highland Place to South End)
Lofts at Evergreen Knoll	(Sewer and Water Main Relocation Only)

Staff anticipates following the standard improvement process. A feasibility report will be filed with Council, staff will conduct a public informational meeting, and a public hearing for consideration of the improvements will follow with City Council.

**INITIATE PROJECT AND ORDER FEASIBILITY REPORT FOR 2021 STREET
RECONSTRUCTION IMPROVEMENTS - CONTRACT 2021-03**

WHEREAS, it is proposed to improve the following streets as part of the 2021 Street Reconstruction Improvements project (Contract 2021-03), including removals, watermain replacement, sanitary sewer replacement, lot services, storm sewer construction, grading, aggregate base, bituminous paving, turf restoration and related improvements and to assess the benefited property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvements, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429:

20th Street NW	(2nd Avenue NW to East End)
Faribault Road	(Highland Place to South End)
Lofts at Evergreen Knoll	(Utility Relocation Only)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the proposed improvements be referred to the City staff and they are instructed to report back to the Council with all convenient speed advising the Council in a preliminary way as to whether the proposed improvements are feasible and as to whether they should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvements, and to determine the estimated cost of the improvements.

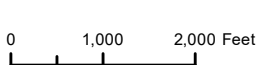
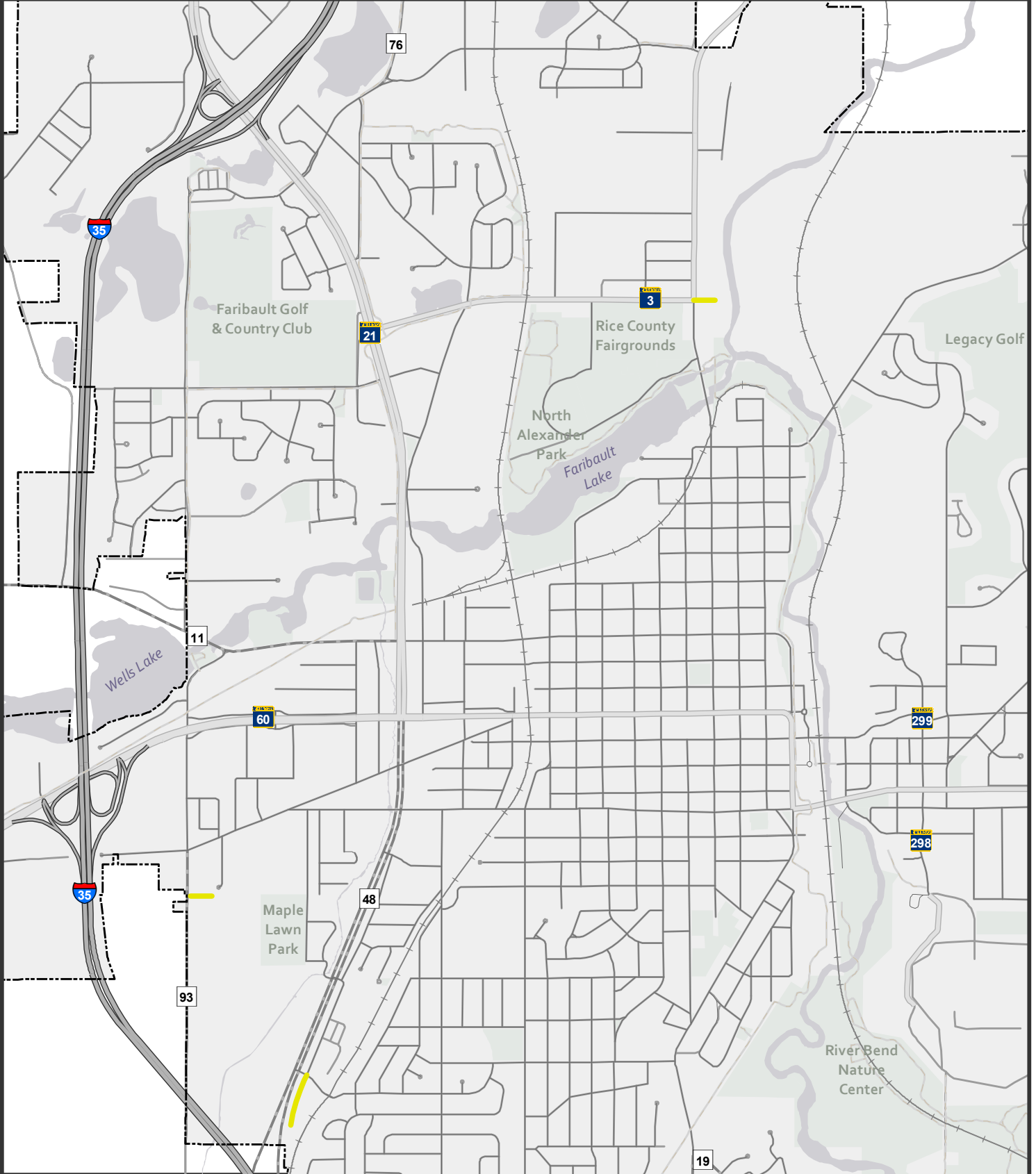
