#### **APPROVE ON-SALE AND SUNDAY LOW VOLUME INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR SHATTUCK-ST. MARY'S DBA THE INN AT SHATTUCK-ST. MARY'S**

**WHEREAS**, Shattuck-St. Mary's dba The Inn at Shattuck-St. Mary's, has submitted an application for an On-sale and Sunday Low Volume Intoxicating Liquor License to be located at 1000 Shumway Ave., in the City of Faribault, consistent with Faribault City Code Chapter 4 and Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 340A; and

**WHEREAS**, Shattuck-St. Mary's dba The Inn at Shattuck-St. Mary's, has paid the required license fees and completed an application packet to request the license; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department has completed a thorough background investigation of the associates of Shattuck-St. Mary's dba The Inn at Shattuck-St. Mary's, and the Chief of Police has certified that the applicants have not been convicted of any violation of any state law or municipal ordinance relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor within the past five years; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Minnesota Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division will be consulted to determine that Shattuck-St. Mary's dba The Inn at Shattuck-St. Mary's, can operate as intended by holding On-sale and Sunday Low Volume Intoxicating Liquor License.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF FARIBAULT RESOLVES**, that Shattuck-St. Mary's dba The Inn at Shattuck-St. Mary's, shall be issued an On-sale and Sunday Intoxicating Liquor License, for the term of February 24, 2021 through December 31, 2021.
