Mental Health Awareness Walk

Background:

Mark Wisdorf has contacted the City regarding hosting the Mental Health Awareness Walk on Wednesday, May 26, 2021, from approximately 12:00 PM to 1:30 PM. This will require some street closures but barricades will not be used and Faribault police and volunteers will assist with the intersections along the route.

The walk will begin at Buckham Memorial Library at 11 East Division Street, proceed west on Division Street, north on 1st Avenue NW, west on 3rd Street NW, south on 3rd Avenue crossing Division Street, east on 1st Street SW, north on 1st Avenue SW to Division Street returning to Buckham Memorial Library.

Approve Resolution 2021-094 to intermittently close the listed roads for the Mental Health Awareness Walk on May 26, 2021.

APPROVE STREET CLOSURES FOR MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS WALK

WHEREAS, Rice County Local Advisory Council is sponsoring the Mental Health Awareness Walk on Wednesday, May 26, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Faribault City Council is supportive of these events; and

WHEREAS, Section 15-57 of the Faribault Code of Ordinances provides for temporary parking restrictions by means of Council resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that locations will be closed intermittently on May 26, 2021, from approximately 12:00 PM to 1:30 PM to allow for the Mental Health Awareness Walk. The walk will begin at Buckham Memorial Library at 11 East Division Street, proceed west on Division Street, north on 1st Avenue NW, west on 3rd Street NW, south on 3rd Avenue crossing Division Street, east on 1st Street SW, north on 1st Avenue SW to Division Street returning to Buckham Memorial Library.
