### **Discussion:**

The Arrival Departure (A/D) building and Fixed Based Operator (FBO) hangar at the Airport were destroyed by storm damage on September 20, 2018. Part of the recovery efforts includes rebuilding these buildings.

Staff met on Friday, April 12, 2019 with representatives from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) Office of Aeronautics, League of Minnesota Cities (LMC) Insurance Trust, State Senate, and the Governor's office to discuss the rebuilding process. Staff will provide an update to the Council on the outcome of that meeting, including the next steps in the rebuilding process for the A/D building and FBO hangar, a tentative timeline for the design and approval process, and the funding of the improvements.
