SUBJECT: Approve Quote for Lighting of Teepee Tonka Park Tunnel

Background:

At the May 28th City Council Meeting, a quote from Slinger Electric was approved to light the tunnel on the south side of Teepee Tonka Park. Recently, the owner of Slinger Electric called to say they are unable to undertake the project. They have encountered some staff resignations and have also been awarded a long-term contract. So, with regret, they are withdrawing their proposal.

We have contacted the next lowest bidder for the project which is Arrow Electric and they are willing to accept the job using their quote, which is \$11,772. This will include a rigid conduit in the tunnel. We will also start the process over again with Xcel regarding bringing power to the tunnel.

The tunnel lights will have multiple settings on them. They will be similar to the tunnel under Highways 3 & 21 where lights are on brighter during the day, half of the lights are on in the evening and all lights go off about 11 PM.

In the 2019 CIP, \$28,000 was budgeted for this project.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approving the withdrawal of the proposal from Slinger Electric and accepting the quote from Arrow Electric for \$11,772 for lighting of the tunnel located south of Teepee Tonka Park.

All Labor, Material and Inspection Fees included per the following:

Base Bid- Electrical Service:

- Install an Xcel Energy approved meter socket near the North end of the tunnel on a 6" x 6" wood post.
 - Install underground wire from the meter socket to the nearest utility pole.
 - Install a service panel on the post with breakers to feed the tunnel lighting.
- *Xcel Energy has not confirmed that we can make connection to their overhead power lines at this location.

Total: \$4,000.00

Base Bid- Tunnel Lighting:

- Install a conduit underground from the service equipment to the north entrance to tunnel.
- Install 20 vandal resistant LED light fixtures inside the tunnel connected with EMT conduit run along the ceiling.
- The lights are anticipated to run 24 hours a day.

Total: \$14,750.00

Optional Add- Tunnel Lighting Control:

- Provide 2 different switching options which would allow every other light fixture to be turned on/off at different time schedules.
