Background:

The Rice County Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) was formed to assist the City of Faribault and the surrounding areas when our resources are stretched thin and more help is needed. The Faribault Fire Department is the sponsoring agency for this group of volunteers.

Discussion:

Rice County CERT had plans to become a 501c3 organization. They began to raise money for equipment and self-promotion. The decision not to pursue the 501c3 status was made and it became necessary to close the bank account. The CERT team would like to donate \$1,002.60 to the City of Faribault Emergency Management budget, which is where needed equipment would be purchased from.
