SUBJECT: Resolution 2020-013 Amend Official Downtown
Parking Restrictions Map

Background:

The Official Downtown Parking Restrictions Map was last amended on May 14, 2019, with the passing of Resolution 2019-091. The resolution included the installation of one 15-minute stall at 326 Central Avenue, which was removed under a previous amending resolution. The installation of the stall was to provide short-term parking in the area for downtown patrons. A change in business use has occurred since the passing of Resolution 2019-091 and the 15-minute stall no longer needed.

The matter was discussed at the January 7, 2020 Joint Committee meeting where the recommendation was made to remove the 15-minute stall. The recommendation for removal aligns with the objective to locate 15-minute stalls consistently at midblock locations, which was included in the most recent map amendment. Attached Resolution 2020-013 amends the Official Downtown Parking Restrictions Map to remove the 15-minute stall near 326 Central Avenue.

RESOLUTION 2020-013 AMEND OFFICIAL DOWNTOWN PARKING RESTRICTIONS MAP

WHEREAS, the City of Faribault maintains an Official Downtown Parking Restrictions Map; and

WHEREAS, the presence of a 15-minute parking space at 326 Central Avenue is no longer necessary; and

WHEREAS, the matter was discussed at the Joint Council Committee on January 7, 2020 where Council directed City Staff to amend the Official Downtown Parking Restrictions Map on the location of 15-minute parking spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Faribault hereby amends the Official Downtown Parking Restriction Map and approves the public parking and parking restrictions as shown on the Official Downtown Parking Restrictions Map dated January 14, 2020, hereto attached. Said restrictions shall supersede all previous resolutions related to parking restrictions in the downtown.

Section 2. The City Council hereby directs the Director of Public Works to affect said parking restrictions and to remove the necessary signage.

Section 3. The enforcement of the parking restrictions will be in full force upon removal of the existing sign.

Section 4. The Director of Public Works is hereby directed to maintain the Official Downtown Parking Restrictions Map and update the map as directed by the City Council.

Section 5. The Mayor, City Administrator, City Staff, and the City's Consultants are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all additional steps and actions necessary or convenient to accomplish the intent of this Resolution including, but not limited to, making minor revisions to the specific location of handicapped accessible parking spaces and 15-minute parking spaces.

Section 6. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and without publication.
