WHEREAS, the following application has been received for a new 3.2% Off-Sale Liquor License:

WHEREAS, the establishment listed has provided the proper fees; proof of Minnesota Workers Compensation Insurance pending review by the City Attorney; provided the necessary Tax Information Form; a Certificate of Real Estate Taxes Paid from the Rice County Treasurer showing that all taxes and assessments are paid to date; and a Background Authorization Form; and

WHEREAS, a thorough background investigation has been completed by the Police Department has been signed by the Chief of Police verifying that the applicant has not been convicted of any violations of any state law or municipal ordinance relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor within the past five years; and
