SUBJECT: Resolution 2020-037 Municipal Approval of Construction Plans for County State Aid Highway 19 (Glynview Trail) Bituminous Overlay and Milling Projects

Background:

Rice County is planning to undertake pavement improvements along County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 19 (Glynview Trail) in 2020 from Willow Street to the City limits. The project is located within the City limits, and as required by State Statute 162.02, Subd. 8, the County is required to obtain City approval for the plans:

162.02 COUNTY STATE-AID HIGHWAY SYSTEM.

Subd. 8. Approval by city.

Except as provided in subdivision 8a, no portion of the county state-aid highway system lying within the corporate limits of any city shall be constructed, reconstructed, or improved nor the grade thereof changed without the prior approval of the plans by the governing body of such city and the approval shall be in the manner and form required by the commissioner.

The primary scope of the improvements is to complete a bituminous mill and overlay (3.5") and restriping of CSAH 19.

Per the Rice County Capital Improvement Plan, the total estimated cost of the improvements in the Rice County Project is \$1,200,000 (\$250,000 for CSAH 19). The project will be funded from the County's street maintenance fund. The City is not being asked to contribute financially to the construction project but will in return not look for the County to participate in the upgrade of existing traffic signals in town with emergency vehicle preemption equipment (EVP).

A full set of plans is available in the Engineering Department. Construction on the project is scheduled to be in the summer of 2020 (probably after school is out) and be completed by the end of September 2020.
