Motion by van Sluis, seconded by Wood to close the Special City Council meeting and carried unanimously. The meeting was closed at 6:00 pm.

The City Council held a Special Council Meeting pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 13D.04, subdivision 2. The Special City Council meeting was closed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 13D.05, subdivision 3(a), to conduct a closed meeting to evaluate the performance of an individual subject to the City Council's authority, Marsden Powell.

Based upon that discussion, the Council directed that staff proceed with preparation of the necessary paperwork for the separation of employment of Mr. Powell due to the inability to perform the essential duties of the job.


Motion by Ross, seconded by van Sluis to approve Resolution 2019-042 Separating Marsden Powell from Employment and carried unanimously.
