Officers Recognized

Three officers were recently recognized for their extraordinary actions. **Officer Keith Voegel** received a lifesaving medal for his actions in performing CPR on an electrocution victim. **Officer John Pesta** was presented with a written commendation for responding to the same hazardous incident and administering first aid to another victim. **Sergeant Matt Long** also received a written commendation for responding to a reported heroin overdose and administering naloxone which revived the victim, who was subsequently transported to the hospital for further treatment.



Repeat Offender

On Saturday, June 2nd, **Officers Josh Sjodin, Kara Christensen, Mallory House, Adam Marvin** and **Sergeant Brandon Gliem** responded to a reported domestic assault. A juvenile male reported he had seen his older brother assault both his parents, including grabbing his mother around the neck. Sgt. Gliem and Ofc. Sjodin encountered the suspect in the kitchen, and when they attempted to detain him he kicked and grabbed Ofc. Sjodin, and actively struggled against both officers until he was finally handcuffed. The victims told the officers that no assault had taken place, although they had visible injuries. The suspect, Edy



Morente Toj, 21, was arrested and jailed. He was charged with 4th degree Assault and two counts of Domestic Assault (gross misdemeanor). His bail was set at \$3,000 with condi-

tions. A Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO) was also issued, barring Morente Toj from returning to the residence and having contact with the victims.

On Wednesday, June 6th, **Sergeant Matt Long** and a Rice County Social Worker returned to the residence as part of a child protection violation. They learned that Morente Toj was inside the residence. **Officers John Pesta and Keith Voegel** responded to assist. Morente Toj was arrested without incident, and he was charged with Violation of a DANCO. His bail in the second case was set at \$10,000 with conditions.

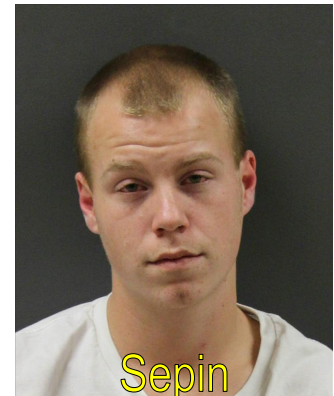
