This week, **Officer John Pesta** was awarded a life saving medal for his actions on July 9th. Ofc. Pesta responded to a motorcycle crash on MN 3. On his arrival, he found a woman lying on the pavement, saw that her arm had been severed and she was lying in a large pool of blood. Seeing that a tourniquet applied by bystanders was not working, Ofc. Pesta applied his

own tourniquet which stopped the blood loss, saving the woman's life.

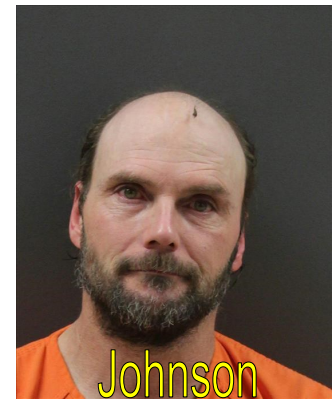
