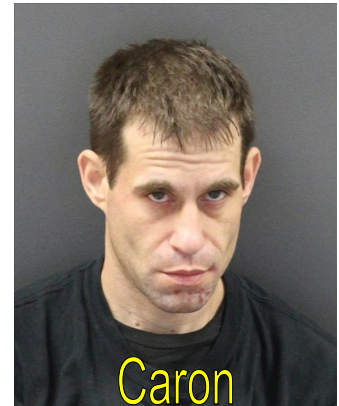

## Drug Arrest

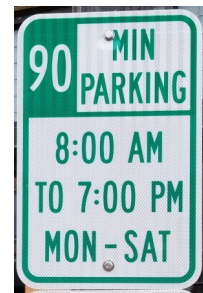
On Monday, December 3rd, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** observed Adam Caron, 39, driving a vehicle. The agents had probable cause to arrest Caron following an earlier narcotics investigation. **Officer Tony Larson** conducted a traffic stop and Caron was arrested. During a search incident to arrest, Caron was found in possession of 30 grams of methamphetamine. In a post-

*Miranda* interview, Caron admitted to selling methamphetamine. He was charged with 1st degree Controlled Substances - Sales and 2nd degree Controlled Substances - Possession. Caron was subsequently charged with 1st degree Controlled Substances - Sales for selling 28.65 grams of methamphetamine during a narcotics investigation. His bail was set at \$100,000 with conditions.
