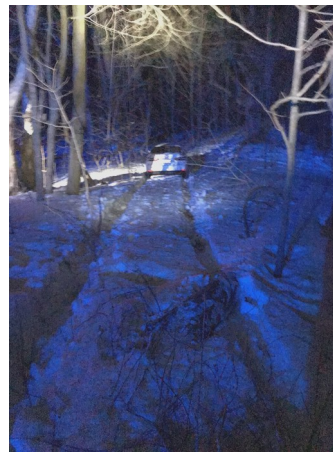
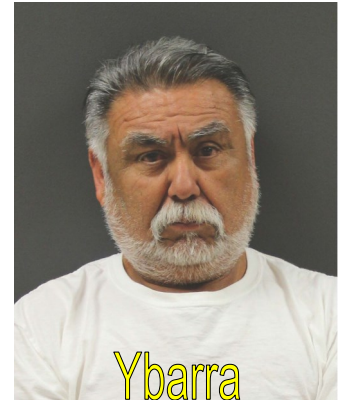

DWI Arrest

On Saturday, March 16th, **Officers Josh Alexander, Bill Considine and Scott Duncan** responded to a crash on I-35. The officers found the vehicle in the trees off the freeway. Ofc. Considine met with a witness, who stated the suspect's vehicle was swerving across both lanes of the interstate before entering the ditch. Ofc. Alexander met with the driver, who displayed signs of narcotics use. The driver, Jorge Ybarra, 61,

was arrested for DWI. A search of his person revealed a baggie containing suspected methamphetamine in his pocket. Ofc. Duncan also located a bottle of "Stay Awake" pills in the vehicle. A search warrant was obtained and a sample of blood was drawn from Ybarra. Ybarra was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances, and his bail was set at \$15,000 without conditions.

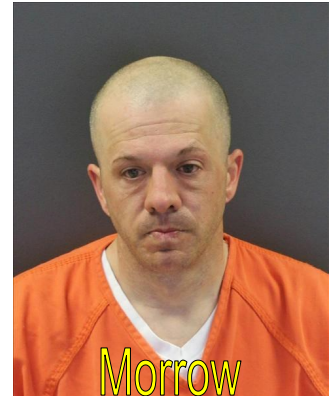

Car Theft

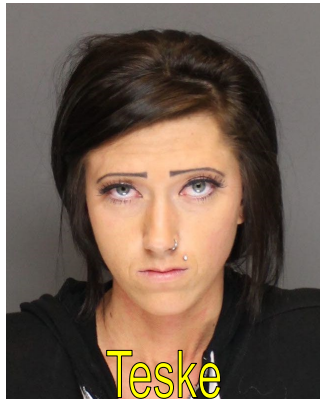
On Monday, March 11th, **Officer Tony Kuchinka** took a report of a stolen vehicle from a local convenience store. **Detectives John Gramling** and **Ben Johns** viewed surveillance footage from the store and identified the suspect. They viewed the suspect inside the store, and noted he used a rewards card inside the store, which helped confirm his identity. They viewed the same suspect approach a customer’s car a short time later and drive

away with it. The detectives put out a notice to officers to locate and arrest the suspect, Kevin Morrow, 40. **Officer Tony Larson** found Morrow on Monday, March 18th, and arrested him for the theft and an outstanding arrest warrant. Morrow was charged with Theft, and released on his own recognizance by the court. The stolen vehicle was later recovered parked at a local business.

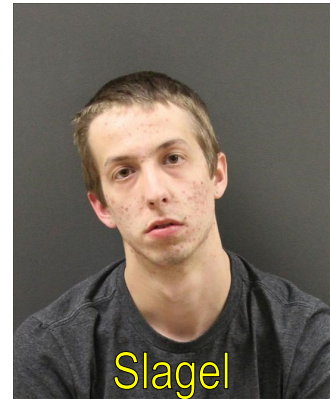


Warrant Watch
