Sexual Assault Awareness Month

As Sexual Assault Awareness Month wraps up, we want to offer some tips on support of survivors. There is no timetable when it comes to recovering from sexual violence. If someone trusted you enough to disclose their event to you, consider the following ways to show your continued support.

Avoid Judgement. Avoid phrases that suggest they're taking too long to recover such as, "You've been acting this way for a while now" or "How much longer will you feel this way?"

Check in periodically. Check in with the survivor to remind them you still care

about their well-being and believe their story.

Know your resources. Become familiar with resources you can recommend to a survivor, such as the National Sexual Assault Hotline, 800-656-HOPE. Locally, HOPE Center offers support and resources, 800-
