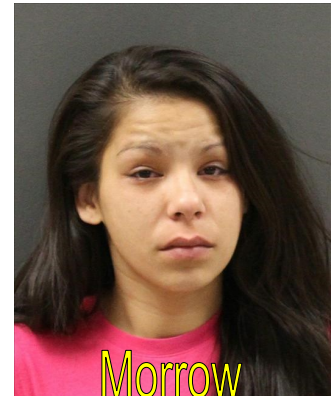

Theft Arrest

On Saturday, June 1st, **Officer Keith Voegel** responded to a local business for a reported shoplifter. He was informed the suspect had switched price tags on several clothing items before paying. A store employee then stopped the suspect, Jennifer Morrow, 24. Morrow admitted the theft to Ofc. Voegel, and acknowledged she had had enough money to pay for the items. She also admitted she had a marijuana pipe in her purse. Ofc. Voegel searched her purse, and located the pipe and other marijuana

paraphernalia, and eight pills of a controlled substance. Morrow stated the pills were for her mother who had a prescription. Morrow was also found to possess a vaporizer with a liquid marijuana cartridge inside. She told Ofc. Voegel the vaporizer belonged to her boyfriend, who had a prescription for marijuana. Morrow was arrested and jailed. She was charged with Theft, 5th degree Controlled Substances (two counts), and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. She was released on her



own recognition by the court.
