## The Family That Tokes Together, Stays Together

On Tuesday, September 3rd, agents of the **Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force** executed a search warrant at a Faribault residence. The agents were assisted by **Detectives Brittany Carstensen, Ben Johns, Officer Josh Sjodin, RCSO Investigators Jason Witt, Dan Belcourt and Nate Hanson.** A search warrant had been executed at the same residence earlier this year, which yielded over four pounds of marijuana and small amounts of cocaine and marijuana wax. Agents had observed continuing evidence of drug sales at the residence. Inside the residence, agents recovered nearly one pound of marijuana, cocaine, THC vaping car-

tridges, packaging and measuring equipment, drug paraphernalia and seized over \$,500 hidden throughout the residence. Three persons were arrested without incident.

Haily Roloff, 18, was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances, and was released on her own recognizance by the court.

Jordan Roloff, 19, was charged with 4th degree Controlled Substances - Sales (School Zone) and 5th degree Controlled Substances. His bail was set at \$25,000 with conditions.

Tami Roloff, 38, was charged with 3rd degree Controlled

Substances (School Zone), 4th degree Controlled Substances - Sales (School Zone), and 5th degree Controlled Substances. Her bail was set at \$30,000 with conditions.

Peter Roloff, 39, was not present and was charged by complaint/warrant with 4th degree Controlled Substances - Sales (School Zone) and 5th degree Controlled Substances. He was arrested by **Officers Bill Considine, Jacob Holm and Josh Alexander** on September 5th, and found in possession of a THC cartridge, resulting in an additional 5th degree Controlled Substances charge. His bail was set at \$30,000 with conditions.
