## Domestic Assault Arrest

On Monday, January 20th, **Officers Scott Duncan, Josh Alexander, Bill Considine, Matt Shuda** and **Sergeant Eric Sammon** responded to a 911 hang-up. Dispatchers advised officers when they called the number back, they could hear people yelling. At the residence, a woman told officers that her husband had broken a door and verbally threatened her. As officers searched for the suspect, Ofc. Duncan found him hiding behind a false wall in a closet. The suspect, Keon



McDowell, 25, was taken into custody for an arrest warrant. During the arrest, McDowell continually resisted the officers and yelled more threats to the victim. While going to the jail, McDowell banged his head into the partition several times, while officers stopped and attempted to calm him down. In addition to the warrant, McDowell was charged with Domestic Assault - felony, and Obstruction of Legal Process. His bail was set at \$15,000 with conditions.

## Another Happy Customer

On Thursday, January 16th, **Officers Sean Smallen, Matt Shuda, and Adam Marvin** were executing a pair of arrest warrants on Travis Ozmun, 45. When the officers informed Ozmun he was under arrest, he became belligerent, calling the officers profane names and swearing at them. As he was being handcuffed, he told officers that he was in possession of a Suboxone strip which belonged to his girlfriend. At that point, a female came out of the

residence and also began yelling and swearing at the officers. As he was being led away, he continued to call the officers names, as well as one of the assistant county attorneys. Ozmun was transported to the jail without incident. In addition to the warrants, Ozmun was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances. He was released on his own recognizance by the court.

## DWI Arrest

On Thursday, January 16th, **Officers Jacob Holm, Michael Shuda, Adam Marvin and Ben Borash** responded to a two-vehicle crash. While officers spoke with one of the drivers, they noted she displayed signs of intoxication. Ofc. Shuda administered field sobriety tests to the driver, Audra Riggle, 30, and she was subsequently arrested. During the crash investigation, officers also found a cup containing suspected alcohol, an open



wine box, and an open whiskey bottle. Riggle told officers that she did not have insurance on her vehicle. At the jail, Riggle consented to a breath test, which showed she had a blood alcohol level of .18%. Riggle was cited for 3rd degree DWI, No Insurance, and Open Bottle. She was released on her own recognizance by the court.

## Warrant Watch

On Tuesday, January 21st, **Detective Jeff Burbank** received a tip on the whereabouts of Jennifer Tuma, 39, who was the subject of a Dakota County arrest warrant. Det. Burbank found Tuma's car, and **Officers Spencer Angle, Tony Larson and Matt Kolling** responded to a local motel to assist. A short time later, Tuma exited the motel and was detained by officers. While in custody, Det. Burbank began to search the purse, and discov-

ered a hypodermic needle, several small baggies with suspected drug residue, and other paraphernalia. Tuma was transported to the jail. A further search of her purse revealed suspected methamphetamine residue in some of the baggies and a small amount of marijuana. In addition to the warrant, Tuma was charged with 5th degree Controlled Substances and her bail was set at \$15,000 with conditions.
