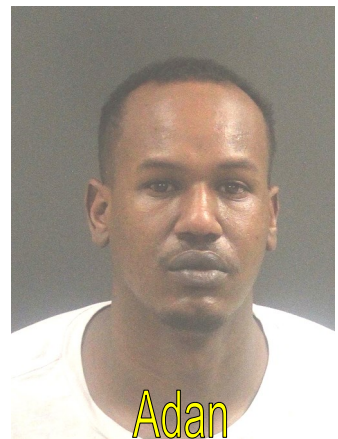
Pursuit Arrest

On Monday, February 28th, **Officer DJ Skluzacek** was on patrol and saw a vehicle make a turn without signaling and failing to stop for a stop sign. As he was catching up to the vehicle, he saw it make another turn without signaling and then accelerating. He attempted to stop the vehicle, which made a third turn and accelerate. As the vehicle continued to flee, it failed to stop for two more stop signs. Ofc. Skluzacek also noted the car "bottomed out" as it went through an intersection. It then lost control and crashed into a snowbank. Of-

icer **Tyler Wilson** responded to assist. The driver, Osman Adan, 26, was taken into custody without incident. Adan told officers that his brakes failed. Officers learned that Adan's driving privileges were "cancelled". After a medical check, he was jailed and charged with Fleeing a Peace Officer. His bail was set at \$5,000 with conditions.

The next day, **Detective Ben Johns** met with a mechanic to inspect the vehicle. It was noted the brakes were operational, no leaks were detected, and the

rotors appeared to only be 2-3 months old.

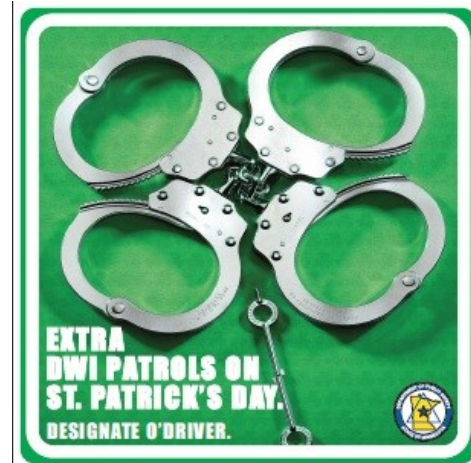
